

### CORE OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

# **Prerequisites:**

- Be a registered member of an SLS Club & have an SLS Members Area account (<u>click here for instructions on</u> how to create one)
- Be a minimum 16 years of age
- Have a current Working with Children Check recorded on Surfguard (please contact your Club officer)

You MUST have a current WWCC (on Surfguard) to be permitted to officiate at SLSSA events

#### There are 3 components to obtaining a Technical Officials Accreditation:

1.
ONLINE COURSE

via SLS Members Area eLearning \$15 fee applicable 2 modules to complete 2.
WORKSHOP
1 x 90min face to face workshop

3.
ON-BEACH PRACTICAL
2 x on-beach carnival practical +
assessment

#### **NOTES:**

- In order for the Technical Officials accreditation to be awarded and recorded on Surfguard, the above 3 components must be completed including copies of the relevant documents received by SLSSA
- Face to face Workshop can be completed <u>BEFORE</u> or <u>AFTER</u> the on-beach practical
- All 3 components must be completed within 12 months of commencing the online course

# **COMPONENT 1 – Online Course**

- a. Log in to the SLS Members Area
  - Go to eLearning (tab across the top)
  - Click on 'Login to eLearning'
  - Go to 'Training Library' (from menu on left hand side of page)
  - Choose 'SLS-Officials' from the course categories (click on VIEW COURSES)
  - Click PURCHASE for 'SLS Core Official'
  - Enter credit card details for the \$15 purchase and click 'PROCESS PAYMENT' a receipt will be emailed to you (email address as per Surfguard)
  - This will allocate the training to you & move the course to 'My Training' (on left hand side menu)
  - Once the course has been allocated to your 'My Training' file, you will be able to access it here as required to complete the online course
- b. Complete the 3 modules (in order) of the online course after successful completion of each module, you will receive an email confirming this. ALL modules need to be 100% completed in order for the 'Core Official Online Theory Modules' to be allocated on Surfguard & for this component to be deemed COMPLETE



#### **MODULE 1 – ASC Officiating Course**

This is a free, external online Australian Sports Commission (ASC) course 'Community Officiating General Principles'

There are 3 parts to this module – all need to be showing as 100% complete in order for the module to be completed



# **COMPONENT 3 – On-Beach Practical (2 x sessions)**

These are actual surf sports carnivals where you will be gradually introduced to the roles you have covered in the online course. You simply:

- a. Use the relevant Google sheet for the carnival of your choice (or as you might be allocated by your Club)
  - i. Junior carnival officials roster
  - ii. Senior carnival officials roster
- b. Add your name to a particular area (ie water area, flags, sprint track, boats) & use the amber colour coding to indicate you are an official in training
- c. At the carnival report to the OFFICIALS hub

Over the course of two (2) carnivals, you will undergo a brief assessment by an Officials Mentor to be signed off for this Component 3.

REMINDER: you <u>MUST</u> have a current WWCC recorded on Surfguard <u>BEFORE</u> you can officiate at a carnival
