

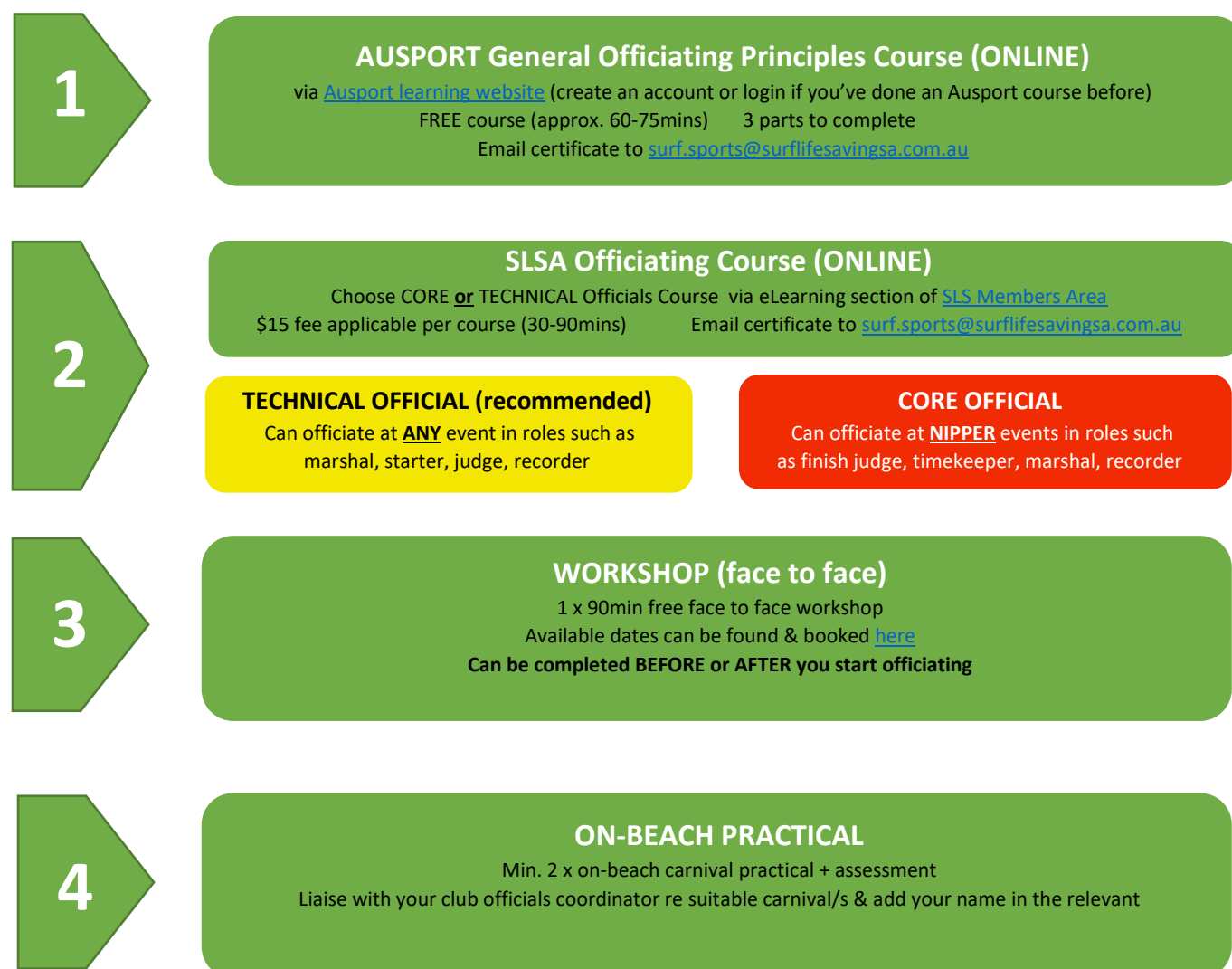
SLSSA CARNIVAL OFFICIATING – Accreditation process

Prerequisites:

- ✓ Be a registered member of an SLS Club & have an SLS Members Area account ([click here for instructions on how to create one](#))
- ✓ Be a minimum 16 years of age
- ✓ Have a current Working with Children Check recorded on Surfguard (please contact your Club officer)

You MUST have a current WWCC (on Surfguard) to be permitted to officiate at SLSSA events

There are 4 components to obtaining a Core Official Accreditation (all to be completed within 12 months):

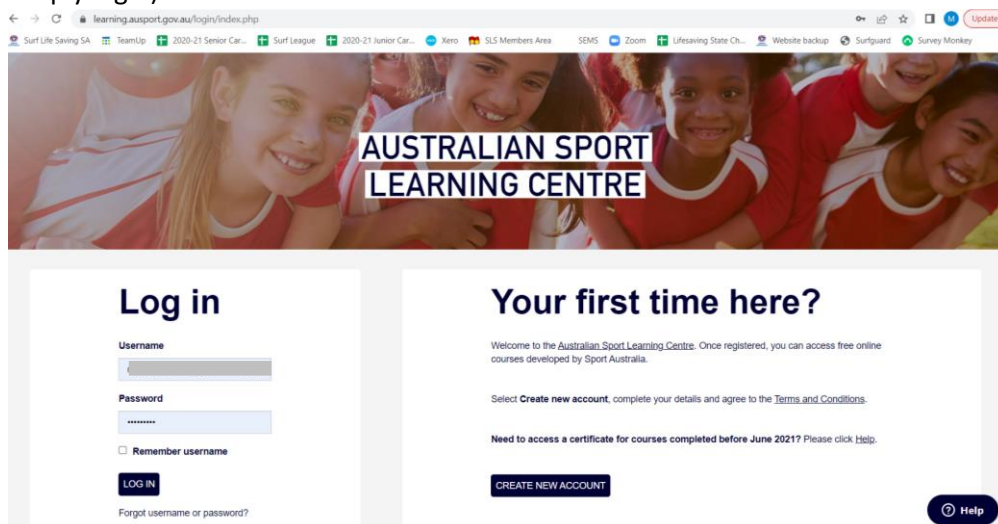

COMPONENT 1:

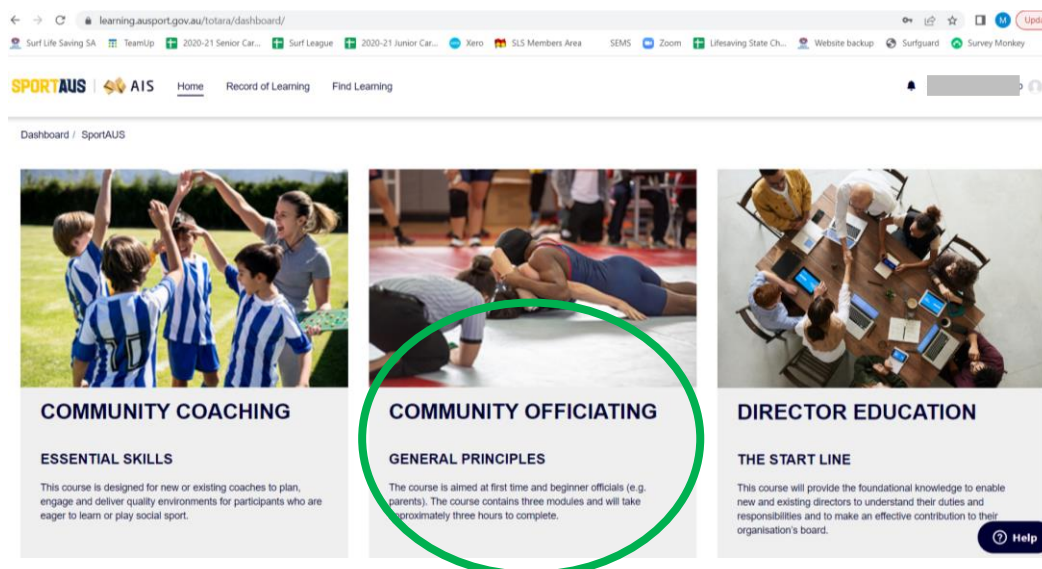
Australian Sports Commission (ASC) Community Officiating General Principles course

This is a free, external online Australian Sports Commission (ASC) course ‘Community Officiating General Principles’

- a. Head to <https://learning.ausport.gov.au/login/index.php> and create a new account (NOTE: if you have previously done any ASC courses such as Coaching General Principles, you will already have an account & can simply login)

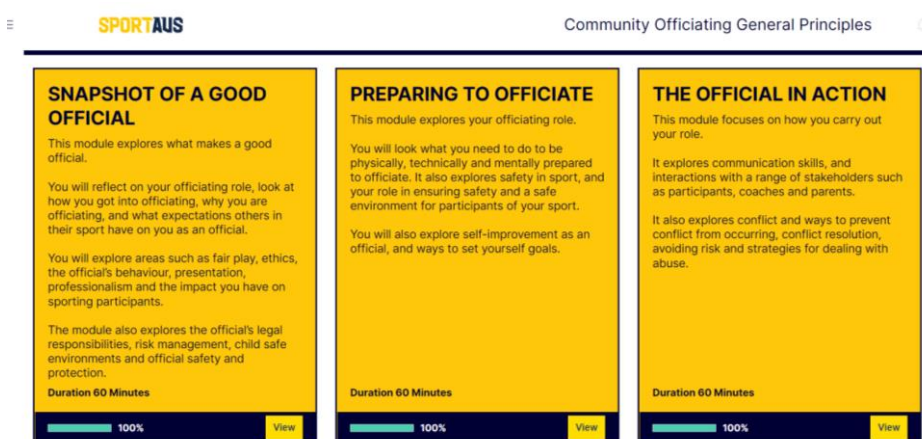


- b. Go to https://www.sportaus.gov.au/coaches_and_officials/officials

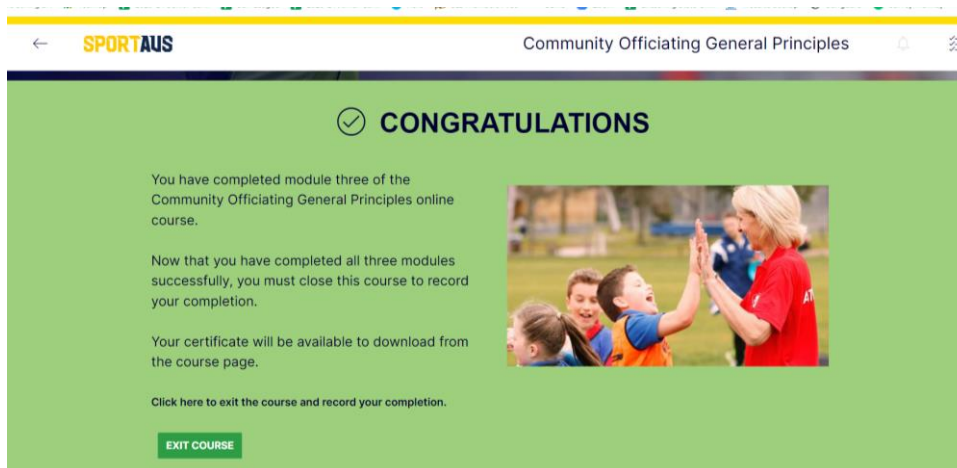


- c. Choose ‘All other Sports’ box and click on ‘ACCESS COURSE’

- d. There are 3 parts to this course – all need to be showing as 100% complete in order for the certification to be awarded



- e. Once completed, you will see this screen



- f. The certificate is awarded once completed (will be emailed to you) which in turn needs to be emailed to surf.sports@surflifesavingsa.com.au (SLSSA will upload the certification to Surfguard)

COMPONENT 2:

SLSA Online Officiating Course – choose TECHNICAL or CORE

- **Technical Officials Course** = can officiate at ANY event (nippers, seniors etc) in a wide range of roles
- **Core Officials Course** = can officiate ONLY at Nipper events in basic roles

SLSSA recommends undertaking the Technical Officials course. Core is NOT a prerequisite to Technical.

- Log in to the [SLS Members Area](#) & access the training via eLearning section
 - Go to eLearning (tab across the top)
 - Click on 'Login to eLearning'
 - Go to 'Training Library' (from menu on left hand side of page)
 - Choose 'SLS-Officials' from the course categories (click on VIEW COURSES)
 - Click PURCHASE for either 'SLS – Technical Official' or 'SLS – Core Official'
 - Enter credit card details for the \$15 purchase and click 'PROCESS PAYMENT' – a receipt will be emailed to you (email address as per Surfguard)
 - This will allocate the training to you & move the course to 'My Training' (on left hand side menu)
 - Once the course has been allocated to your 'My Training' file, you will be able to access it here as required to complete the online course

COMPONENT 2 – Workshop (face to face)

Face to face Workshops are scheduled regularly throughout the season.

You will be required to ATTEND 1 x Workshop from your choice of scheduled dates/times/locations.

COMPONENT 3 – On-Beach Practical (min. 2 x sessions)

These are actual surf sports carnivals where you will be gradually introduced to the roles you have covered in the online course. You simply:

- a. Use the relevant Volunteer roster allocation sheet for the carnival of your choice (or as you might be allocated by your Club)
 - i. Junior carnival officials roster
 - ii. Senior carnival officials roster
- b. Add your name to a particular area (ie water area, flags, sprint track, boats) & use the amber colour coding to indicate you are an official in training
- c. At the carnival report to the OFFICIALS hub

Over the course of two (2) or more carnivals, you will undergo a brief assessment by an Officials Mentor to be signed off for this Component 3.

*REMINDER: you **MUST** have a current WWCC recorded on Surfguard **BEFORE** you can officiate at a carnival*

Congratulations! Now that you have completed the following:

- ✓ WWCC current & recorded on Surfguard
- ✓ Online SLSA Core Officials course (both modules; certificates emailed to surf.sports@surflifesavingsa.com.au)
- ✓ Attended a face to face Workshop
- ✓ Attended 2 x carnivals & have assessment completed

You will be awarded the SLSA Official accreditation (*Core or Technical depending on which course you have completed*) on your Surfguard profile & the expiry date automatically set as 31 December in 3-4 years time.
