## About Morgan:

Morgan is a dual completer from Sacramento, CA who graduated in 2014 from Harvard University, *magna cum laude*, with highest honors in neurobiology at 20 years old. While at Harvard, she received first place at the National Collegiate Research Conference for her senior thesis, The Emergence of Orientation Invariant Representations in Ventral Visual Cortex. She was also the winner of the Hoopes Prize for outstanding thesis work, and was one of the top nine nominees for the Fay Prize, which recognizes the thesis that demonstrates the most imaginative work and original research in the university. Morgan recently taught at a summer program in Mind, Brain and Behavior at the Harvard Summer School in Italy, and is currently a researcher at Harvard's Moral Cognition Laboratory where she and a team of investigators are developing computational models of reinforcement learning. At a young age, Morgan began acting, and was featured in episodes of *Mad About You*, *The Guardian*, and *Chicken Soup for the Soul*, as well as several national commercials for companies like Frito-Lay and Disney. Morgan quit the business at age nine to focus on school, but she has continued to participate in plays and vocal music throughout her elementary, high school and college years. Staying committed to Kumon wasn't always easy; sometimes Morgan had difficulty finding enough hours in the day to complete her Kumon work on top of everything else.
