CALL TO WORSHIP

Read <u>Psalm 23</u> This is the word of the Lord. **ALL: Thanks be to God.**

COMMUNITY CONFESSION

Leader: Seeking to follow Jesus, we often wander down the wrong roads. Impatient with God's schedule, we rush off to do things our way. Let us confess our foolishness, that we might receive God's hope for our lives.

SCRIPTURE READING & PRACTICE INTRO

Acts 2:42-47

LORD'S TABLE LITURGY

Leader: As we gather to celebrate this day, as we remember the gifts Jesus shared, we proclaim that faith which is a mystery: ALL: Christ died, his last breath stolen from him; Christ was raised, the Spirit's breath bringing new life; Christ will come, breathing new grace and hope in our lives.

Leader: Here, where the bread and the cup wait, breathe your Spirit upon these gifts. Here, where the young long for visions, and the old whisper their memories, breathe your Spirit upon us, Holy God. Let us not be content simply to eat the bread, but be strengthened by it.
