



## Environmental Policy

KK Fine Foods PLC based at Deeside in North Wales produces part and fully cooked frozen veg, meat, fish and sous-vide products. Producing over 500,000 meals of product on average, per week, and employing over 350 full time staff to do this, we supply throughout the UK into both food service and retailers.

As growth of the business continues we recognise that our operations have an impact on the environment, currently we recycle 100% of our factory cardboard and paper waste, and are committed to the continual environmental improvement of our other activities. We also consider other activities such as specific customer requirements with regards to the environment.

We are also committed to the prevention of pollution and that we ensure all activities conducted by the organisation comply with all relevant environmental legislation.

Key areas of impact of this operation are energy and waste. In recognition of this we have implemented an environmental management system.

We aim to;

- Recycle 100% of plastics waste by August 2017
- Reduce volume of waste YOY versus volume of product created in all areas
- Implement initiatives for all staff to have input in the development of the environmental management system
- Development of an awareness campaign internally for energy and water reduction
- Implement energy & waste KPI's tracked monthly by the GM.

These and other actions form part of the sites improvement plan which are tracked via a critical path.
