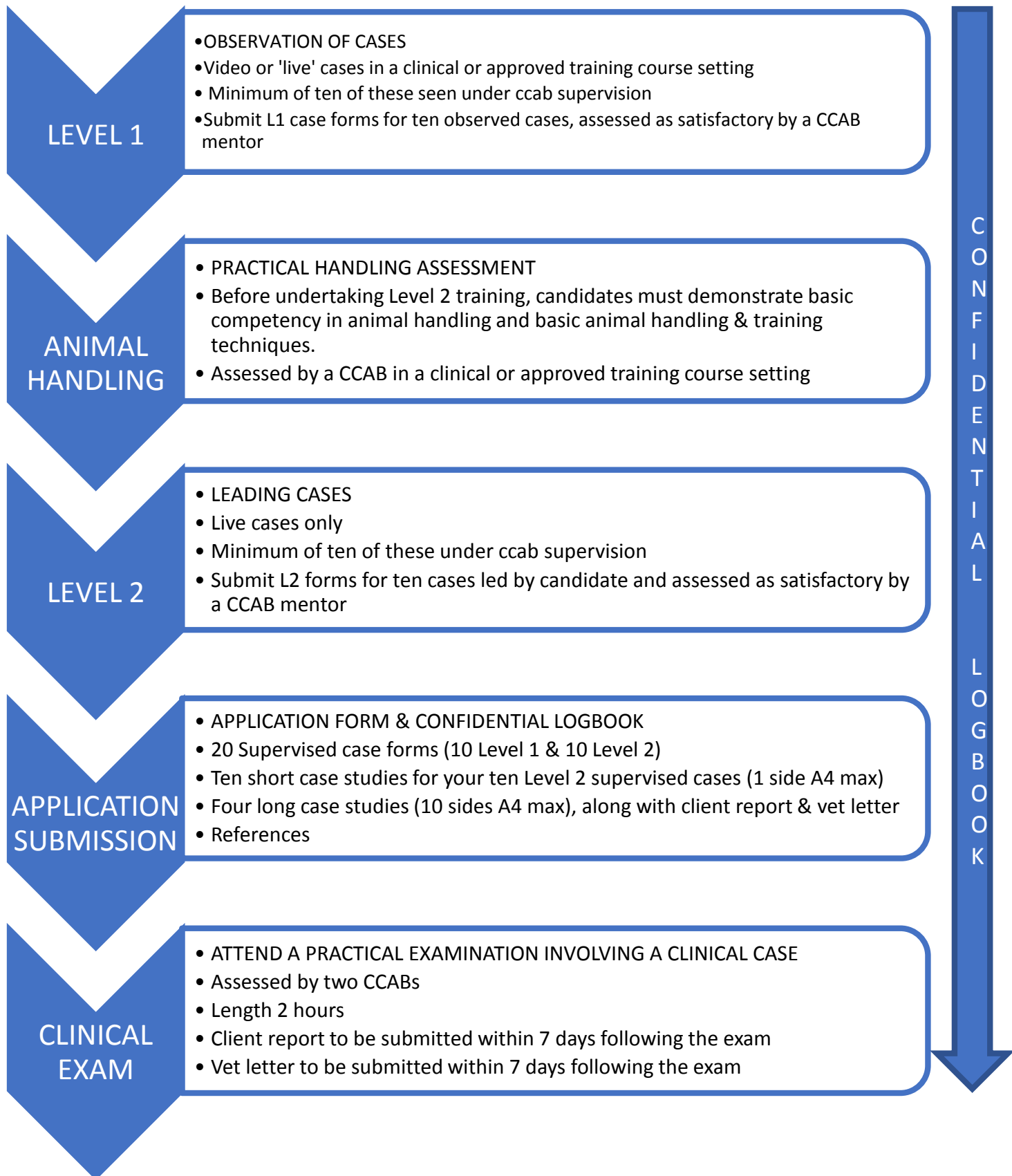


Supervised Experience Requirements for CCAB Accreditation



Notes

For an inexperienced applicant we estimate that it will require around 40 cases to become competent, however only ten of these cases must be 'live' cases seen in the presence of a CCAB mentor and signed off as competent.

The confidential logbook should include a range of cases as listed in Appendix 2 of Handbook2.

Applicants must show interspecies knowledge in their confidential logbook:

i.e. if an individual wishes to register just for dogs, then s/he must see at least one cat house soiling case. If an individual wishes to register just for cats, then s/he must see at least two dog cases (both involving aggression) to meet the requirement for certification.
