2. Bootstraps (Career Pathway Training)

Reporting:

Highlights

1. On 22 July 2011, the career pathways training in Group III (S. L. and O. S.) finished their training at HAGAR.
2. The career pathways training who are receiving vocational training outside studies regularly, and they have meetings with other groups to discuss the problems they face.
3. We arranged for a meeting with the group of career pathways training and we encouraged them to join the training and to work hard (ie. attend training skills, going to study regularly).

Challenges

1. N. S. was absent from the vocational training school because she is two months pregnant two months ago. She says that when she goes for study she always feels sleepy so hence decided to stop studying. HAGAR has since suspended her for three months.
2. S. S. always changes her day off to go to vocational training (ie. she studies on Sunday but she did not go, but attended on her day off on Tuesday).
3. Some teenagers come to vocational training late as they have problems with their health.

3. Family Visits and Counseling

Highlights

1. Some of career pathways trainees studied at the vocational training regularly and received good results in their study.
2. Provided food boxes to career pathways trainees every Friday.
3. Provided counseling to get ready girls (S., C., S.)with regards to their behavior and attitude in respect of their studies and when they take walks outside.
4. S. D. came to study again when the state school opened.
5. Mr. Sok Chay, who is doing an internship of social work at Kilomet6 visited 8 families who had problems.
6. The social work department cooperated with the micro-business department to follow up on women who borrowed money from Riverkids to do small businesses.
7. Took children in Old Riverkids to the hospital for treatment.
8. The social work department went to the community to assemble the new get ready boy group, new get ready girl group and kindergarten for intern new program at Riverkids.
9. The social work department went to visit students outside of Riverkids to help them with school fees and school materials.
10. Mr. Chin Chea followed up with students who were absent from class in Compassion House.
11. The family at the other slum cooperated with us when we went to collect new kids and follow up on students who were absent from class.

Challenges

1. Some students were absent this month because it is break-time at the state school.
2. Some families who have daughters do not encourage their daughters to study vocational training and instead forced them to collect trash and work at karaoke places at night.
3. Some 18 year old teenagers do not concentrate well on their studying.
4. The children's parents do not pay much in our efforts of promoting their children to study and this result in children being absent daily.
5. Some families move to live at other places from the Riverkid's area without informing us.

6. Some parents who are jobless and spends their time playing games forces the kids to collect trash to earn money to support the family.
7. Some parents still prioritise their children collecting trash than making them study.
8. When we visit some families in the community, they are not at home.
9. This month as the social workers had a lot of work to complete, the schedule was changed accordingly.
10. Some students were absent from the Riverkids class because the teachers at the state school forced them to study part-time in the mornings.
11. This month, the slum along river site had blood and that made it very difficult for family visitations.
