1. 27 families are visited by social teams
2. 5 women and 9 kids are consulted and given advice by social teams
3. Enrolled 42 new children in Kindergarten at Psar Touch community
4. Followed up on 8 students who were absent from class and the feedback was given to education office
5. Took the patients, including students and their parents to hospital (5cases)
6. Led casfile staff in a visit to the community to interview students' families as planned
7. Selected 10 poor families to join in gift sharing activities donated by ANZ Royal
8. Helped coordinate 200 students and 10 poor families in gift sharing activities on October 23, 2011
9. Participated in the sharing of books and other school materials to Out Project students in new academic year
10. Paid for school fee for students (Out Project)
11. Added more information to the 42 case file forms for new student recruitment
12. Sent three kids to hospital
13. Guided a group of five people on the advocacy walk
14. Led 10 boys and 5 foreigners to clean the wall and mural painting
15. Completed the registration form of 50 kids for new kindergarten of academic year 2011-2012
16. Guided the boys and girls to football training every Saturday morning
17. Attended a case conference with HAGAR about drug abuse in families

18. 60 young women from The Bootstrap Project, Butterfly and Micro Business joined external training with Sophat, an independent trainer on 21 Oct 2011 about conception change.

19. Urgently assisted 35 families in Psar Touch village who were affected by flood by giving tarpaulins for temporary settlements and rice for 5 students' families at Areyksat and Chbar Ampov where serious flooding occurred

1. Ms. S. L. stopped working at Chruy Chengva, but now has a new job as a cashier at Tang kea Internet shop with a salary of 60\$/month.
2. Ms. O. S. stopped working at Chaom Chov, but now has a new job as a Chef at Chinese Factory with a salary of 100\$/month.
3. Ms. N. S. and Ms. N. S. are going to finish their vocational training next month (Sewing skill). After that, they will work there and each of them will get a salary of 120\$ per month. Because they study hard and are believable, people and their teachers are interested in them.

### Challenges

1. *There are some problems with their health that absent them from the class.*
2. *Ms. S. L. and Ms.O. S. do not have high expectations, so frequently change jobs.*

1. 27 families were visited by social workers

2. Because of the limited budget of the organization, our help to those victim families were relatively insufficient and belated; consequently, we social workers were often blamed when visiting communities.
3. We often lacked colleagues when visiting communities.

### Next Month

Please briefly describe activities planned for next month

1. Will go to visit families of Career Pathways Training at HAGAR every week and at their work place outside.
2. Will pay visits to Phsar Touch, Blum, Km six, and Compassion house every week to follow up on the problems of the kids' parents.

3. Will continue cooperation with other social staff, Mr. Chin Chea, to visit communities such as Railway, Blum, and Kilometer6 to enroll five-year kids in the kindergarten of each area. According to our plan, we will have to select 120 students for the above kindergartens.
4. Will Prepare to send two patients who need health consultation to CSI hospital.
5. Will continue leading Casefile staff to interview students' families.
6. Will visit 15 students' families to understand more about the difficulties of each family ,find out which is the most vulnerable and find solutions to help them, for example by sending their children to school.
7. Meet five students who often play truant, and consult to find out how to encourage them to attend class regularly
8. Set up plans to cooperate with the local authority.
9. Will provide counseling for family or children who have problems with their studies
