Appendix A: Junior College Detailed Activities

National Junior College

Date: 16th to 17th December 2011

This group came to Riverkids through Mr. Jacky, who has given several used computers to Riverkids in the past. Mr. Sophon knows this man.

We were informed they were coming on the day before their arrival. On the afternoon of the 15th December, Mr. Sophal called our volunteer coordinators about a group of volunteers from Singapore. We were reluctant to accept them on such short notice. However, we were worried that our refusal might result in no further cooperation so we accepted and rushed to communicate with all the relevant staff and organize the activities for the following day.

Brief Activities

16 December

After their arrival and briefing about the project of Riverkids, the student volunteers were divided into two groups, each consisting of 11 members. One group taught the kindergarten class while the other taught the grade class. Both groups worked only in the Family House. Their teaching focused mainly on funny folded paper.

17 December

The next day, the students were again divided into two groups, one of which consisted of six members. The six-member group was responsible for decorating two English classes at the central office. This involved hanging posters along the walls of the classroom.

The other group worked with the kids in Family House conducting a Funfair for around sixty kids; thirty in the morning and the other thirty in the afternoon. The funfair was held only in the morning. The students invited to the funfair were grade class students from 7 to 14 years old.

During the funfair, the volunteers were divided into subgroups – seven groups. Each group consisted of three members, and there was a general leader who was responsible for supervising the subgroups.

Funfair activities

The first group was responsible for providing healthy food to the children. The food included salad, melon, fish sauces, longan, cucumber, cabbage, papaya, pineapple and mango. The second group taught physical warm up exercises. The third group taught the students about food and the food pyramid. In this group the students were asked to call out the name of foods they knew, and the group explained each food to them in a funny and easy-to-understand way. The fourth group was responsible for teaching the children to play ball sports. The fifth group taught students about the importance of water. The sixth taught them how to clean their teeth properly. The last group taught the students the dangers of smoking cigarettes.
