I. MONTHLY REPORT SUMMARY:

A. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Alexandra/ Family House Center:** Trained a new kindergarten teacher, updated the job description and presented the Riverkids Foundation's vision, mission, and goals to them, registered 3 kindergarten children, provided 52 uniforms to after school tuition program students, prepared the schedule and recruited 48 adult students who have studied at state school in grade 6 to 12, 18 student were recruited to participant football activities, and continued teaching Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science Books in after school tuition classes of grade 1 and 2.
- **Blum House Center:** Provided 46 uniforms to English Students, registered and sent 12 high commitment English Student at Central Office Center to Blum House, 12 students were recruited to participate in the football activities, provided 12 Logo Loves Books, Level II, Student Book to 12 new students, continued teaching English Classes, and trained a new local volunteer.
- **Compassion House Center:** Provided 49 uniforms to after school tuition program children, updated teacher job descriptions and presented the Riverkids Foundation's vision, mission and goals to them, 1 female child return to our program, continued teaching Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science Books in after school tuition classes from grade 1 to 5.
- **Center Office Center:** Provided 58 uniforms to after school tuition program children, updated the teacher job description and presented the Riverkids Foundation's vision, mission, and goals to them, continued teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes from grade 2 to 4, there were 2 wall fans installed in the new class, and there were 30 students recruited to participate in football activities.
- **KM6 House Center:** Provided 29 uniforms to after school tuition program children, updated teacher job description and presented the Riverkids Foundation's vision, mission, and goals to them, continued teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes from grade 2 to 4, there were 5 students recruited to participate in football activities, moved class from GRG class to old KM6 Center.



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- **External-Football:** There were 30 adult participants in football sessions, 7 new adults attended this program, we continued teaching 4 football sessions to those adults.
 - **Internal Choir Song:** 30 children participated and learned how to sing the song, there were 5 new children, we continued teaching new songs.

B. MAIN CHALLENGES:

- **Alexandra/ Family House Center:** Need to fix the roof of the house where we have conducted after school tuition class, there were 8 children who were absent (1 child sick 4 days), there were 5 children who quit for a week, and there was 1 child who absent for a whole month; we need 18 school bags for children in the new academic year;
- **Blum House Center:** Need a new floor fan, there were 5 students who were absent, and there were 2 students who quit for a week; we need 33 school bags for children in the new academic year;
- **Compassion House Center:** Need a new floor fan, there was a child who absent, and there were 5 children who quit for a week, we need 31 school bags for children in the new academic year;
- **Central Office Center:** There was a child who absent, there were 7 children who quit for a week, and there were 3 children who were absent for a whole month; we need 36 school bags for our children, and need a full time teacher assistant.
- **KM6 House Center:** There were 4 children who were absent (1 child was sick), there were 5 children who quit for a week, and there were 3 children who were absent for a month; we need 22 school bags for children in the new academic year;
- **External-Football:** some adult students did not participate in this program regularly;
- **And Internal-Choir Song:** some children did not participate in this program regularly;

C. NEXT'S MONTH PLAN:



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- **Alexandra/ Family House Center:** Continue teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes for grades 1 to 3 Teaching by RI Student Team, Teachers will attend Introduction to Education of Special Needs and Teaching Strategies Training, Organize Science Fair by RI Team, continue to organize the Computer Class (Student Books, Computer, and Class);
- **Blum House Center:** Continue teaching the English Classes, Teaching English by RI Student Team, Teachers will attend Introduction to Education of Special Need and Teaching Strategies Training, organize Science Fair by RI Team, Samantha Group Team teach English, continue to increase the numbers of English Students from Central Office Center.
- **Compassion House Center:** Continue teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes for grades 1 to 5, Teachers will attend Introduction to Education of Special Needs and Teaching Strategies Training, organize Science Fair by RI Team, Samantha Group Team Teaching;
- **Central Office Center:** Continue teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes for grades 1 to 4, Teachers will attend Introduction to Education of Special Needs and Teaching Strategies Training, organize Science Fair by RI Team, Samantha Group Team Teaching;
- **KM6 House Center:** Continue teaching the Khmer, Mathematic, Society-Science books in after school tuition classes from grades 1 to 4, Teachers will attend Introduction to Education of Special Needs and Teaching Strategies Training, organize Science Fair by RI Team, re-organize class at KM6, and run new kindergarten class of 25 kids;
- **External-Football:** Continue teaching 4 sessions of football, increase and encourage the adult students to participant this program;
- **Internal-Choir Song:** Continue teaching 3 sessions of review and new songs, increase and encourage the adult students to participant this program;
