1.-Project's Name: Get Ready Training Program

Staff in charge of report: Mr. Sok Sambor

I. Highlights

- One boy named H.V., GRB III, who took an air conditioning course at Friend Organization, graduated. He has been working at an air conditioner repair shop. He gets 4\$/day or 120\$/month.
- One girl named Y.S., GRG VI, who studied a course on hairdressing at Friend Organization, graduated and now she has been working in a Hair Salon. She gets 60\$/month.
- One boy named P.S., GRB IV, who studied soft-training at Get Ready for Boys class within Riverkids, graduated from Riverkids. Now, he works as a tuk tuk driver. His uncle who is a tuk tuk driver promised him that if he changed his behavior to be a good boy he would loan him money to buy a tuk tuk. Now that he has proven himself, his uncle has loaned him money to buy one.
- Three girls who graduated from Get Ready for Girls cycle VIII are sent to study vocational training at Friend Organization. S.S. is registered to study sewing, while P.S. and T.T. are both registered for Hair Salon class.
- Cooperated with micro-business to coordinate 4 Get Ready for Girls and 12 boys to attend a training conducted by Danielle, an Oxfam volunteer from Oxfam Quebec about "Budgeting".
- Provided pocket money and cooperated with micro-business to provide direct cash aid to families and students.

II. Challenges

- There is one girl the GR program sent to register for vocational training at Friend Organization who was rejected. Now, she has moved to live far away from Riverkids.

- This month we had a long holiday and our social workers are busy with their own activities so were unable to complete the selection of Get Ready for Girls cycle 9.

III. Plan for Next Month:

- GR Program is going to start a new class of Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 and continue to cooperate with social workers to recruit girls.
- GR Program is going to cooperate with micro-business to talk to parents of Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 about direct cash aid and program policy.
- GR Program is going to arrange an interview with our volunteers for 2 GRB III, 2 GRG VII, 2GRB IV, and 2 GRG VIII to find out the strengths and weaknesses of our program.
- GR Program is going to cooperate with Sara, a foreign volunteer from Australia, to finish an English book for use in Get Ready Training Program.
- GR Program is going to cooperate with the Hagar Organization to coordinate orientating skills programmes for 11 of our boys at the organization.
- GR Program is going to coordinate Get Ready Girls cycle 9 to go on a field trip to Choum Ka Pring resort.
- GR Program is going to the Friend Organization to follow up with students and meet with staff, as well as to interview Susan, a foreign volunteer.
- Provide pocket money and direct cash aid to families and students.
