Department Summary

Please summarize your department's work this month

- Visited 56 families who are living at Psa Touch, Railway II, Blum, Samky villages. This is an outlying project to figure out their problems and to understand their living situations.
- Provided counseling to 3 students, 6 ladies at Training Skills Program, and seven families.
- Recruited two GRB and one GRG to join GR Program.
- Ms. S L started working as a cleaner at a stall and earned \$ 30 per month.
- C R was allowed to join the Weekly Boarder Program at Blum.
- Ms. S R decided to study at the State School half a day and to attend training half a day.
- Ms. P T enrolled in a Sewing Program after being rescued from trafficking.
- Ms. T P registered in a Bootstrap Project in which the training started on 05 November 2012 at Hagar. Also, her daughter registered in a Baby Belly Program.
- Accompanied two families to Phnom Penh Court for Abuse Cases. They are S K's family and R S's family.
- Contacted the authorities normally once a week, in case of any problems or abuses happening in the community such as family domestic violence or human trafficking.

Highlights

1. Ms. S L started working as a cleaner at a stall and earned \$ 30 per month.
2. C R was allowed to join the Weekly Boarder Program at Blum.
3. Ms. S R decided to study at the State School half a day and to attend training half day.
4. Ms. P Th enrolled in a Sewing Program after she was rescued from trafficking.
5. Ms. T P registered in a Bootstrap Project in which the training started on 5th November 2012 at Hagar. Also, her daughter registered in a Baby Belly Program.
6. D and I A evaluated four families at Phsar Touch, three families at Samky, Beng Salang and three families at Compassion House.
7. Miss. K S, of Bootstrap Program, graduated from Soft Skills Training at HAGAR organization.
8. D gave a cushion to S P's baby, as requested.
9. D and S provided a baby cushion, a milk bottle, shampoo and some clothes to Ms. T P's baby at Compassion House.
10. Interviewed three families for assessment for Direct Aid Case at Compassion House.
11. Accompanied two families to Phnom Penh Court for Abuse Cases. They are S K's family and R S's family.
12. Accompanied a group of four people who came from England to conduct the Advocacy Walk.
13. Participated in a YMCA Forum with the focus on "Enrolling for the New School Year 2012-2013".
14. Helped a volunteer to measure kids' shoes at four sites.
15. Followed up on two kids who were absent for a week from the Weekly Boarder Program.

16. Evaluated two families for Direct Aid Case.
17. Got more detailed information from Ms. S P's family who complained to the court and needed help.
18. Contacted the authority normally once a week, in case of any problems or abuses happening in the community such as family domestic violence or human trafficking.

Challenges:

1. A few parents did not attend the Parents' Meeting on time and much time was wasted.
2. One kid who moved back to his homeland did not let the team know where he was.
3. Increasing requisition work from RKF such as house renting and electrical supply expenses.
4. V V was informed to take back his bicycle on 26 or 27 Sep 2012. He still had not yet come to take back the bicycle because he was reluctant to enter State School.
5. Ms. N P in the Bootstrap Program, outside RKF, was always absent from vocational training because her health was not good.
