1. There are 726 (384 female) clients who has been attending the Riverkids program (2007- 2012):

5. Mentor program:

- 12 mentor's letter were translated and passed to the children this month.
- 13 "smarty-pants" are in the process of completing the documents for applying to the mentor program.

Challenges

1. Casefiles unit is waiting to collect children's letters, and the "smarty pant's" document and to pass it to the Singapore office because of EV 71. All the organizations, state schools and Riverkids have closed the classes, and so that's why some children have chance to visit their hometowns and other places.
2. Casefiles unit have a bit complication to divide and classify the client's numbers, status and program when comparing with Case files's policy. For example, there was one kid who was absent for the whole month and more, and the education unit will note that he/ she dropped out in their list. In contrast, the Casefiles policy states that one client will only be noted that they have dropped out from the Riverkids program if they are absent for over three months.
3. Casefiles unit will have to improve the data management system well if the other departments are able to provide detailed and completed information.

She really wants to learn a good skill and to earn some income to support her family. She does not want to work as a night worker, and thus is committed to study in sewing room.</i>	
<i>K.C.</i>		<i>Currently, she's staying at home, and she does not have any work to do. She does not have any skill to help her in her life because she only has a primary level education. She and her family are in a very poor and difficult situation. She had several jobs to support her family, like collecting garbage, working in restaurant as waitress and being a Karaoke girl for two years. However, she did not want to work there. Actually, she wants to get a life skill. Nowadays, she is living with her older sisters and brothers in a rented room. They do not enough income to support their family. Therefore, she is very happy to attend the sewing training.</i>	
<i>P.S.</i>		<i>She wants to have a skill handy after she graduates sewing class. Nowadays, she does not have any work to do besides working as a Karaoke girl in a restaurant. She is married to her husband who is a construction worker. Their income is very low per and cannot support the whole family per month. She has worked as a sex worker for 6 years in her life. However, she does not want to work there. She is committed to stop working as a sex worker and a Karaoke girl to attend sewing class. She really happy to be a part of this program.</i>
