Department Summary

Please summarize your department's work this month

- 1- Followed up with absentee students from the state school and extra classes.
- 2- Visited family in four communities such as Psa Tuoch, Samky, Railways and Doeumkvet villages.
- 3- Provided counseling and discussion with family and children in the community.
- 4- Social team and education staff recruited new GRB to join the GRB program.
- 5- Attended external workshop and training.
- 6- Social team cooperated with volunteer to put some Liter of light in four communities.
- 7- Social team led an advocacy walk.

Family Visits and Counseling

Highlights

- V. P. and V. V. from Samky village returned to study at the state school.
- T. S. N. returned to join the sewing training at Nyemo.
- Visited **27 families** at Psa Touch, Railway II, Doeum Kvet, and Samky village in order to understand more about their situation and to build a relationship with them.
- Provided counseling to **14 children, one woman, and two families.**
- Provided counseling to **10 children.**
- Followed up with **30 students** who were absent from the state school and extra classes at communities such as Psa Touch, Doeum Kvet, Railway, and Samaky village.

Challenges

- S. L.'s family could not cope on their own without support from Riverkids.
- S. P.'s family moved without informing the social department or other departments.
- A few families did not cooperate and did not encourage their children to study regularly such as C. H., C. R., R. T. family.
- A few families are very poor, so the kids decided to stop their studies at the state school and collect cans to support their families.
- A few families did not inform Riverkids staff when they moved to live in other places which are far from Riverkids.
- The team had to cope with many tasks at the same time and the team could not solve all of them at the same time.

Next Month

Please briefly describe activities planned for next month

- Family visit at 4 communities which Riverkids operate in.
- Follow up with old students who are undergoing skills training at external agencies.
- Meet students who undergo training at Hagar every week.
- Follow up with absentee students.
- We will provide training to the community on the negative effects of alcohol. (By Davan and Sokkhim)
- **Ms. Davan** will attend training at first step (Boys first) on 18, 19 and 20 July 2012.
- Social teams will cooperate with the education department to recruit GRB. (Davan and Sambo)
- We will provide counseling to children, women and their families who face crises. (By Davan And Sokkhim)
- I will observe student attendants who undergo vocational training outside and at Hagar.
- **Miss. Sokkhim** and education team are training children at Myamo NGOs.
- Follow up on Y. S. case at Psa Touch village.
