- The Vocational Training program at Riverkids Centre was evaluated by an external evaluator
- The Micro-Business Assistant helped the Social staff with the selection and registration of women for the next program
- The Micro-Business Assistant attended Seven Habit Training at Chab Dai
- The Micro-Business Assistant cooperated with social staff, education staff and Friend NGO staff in respect of S R who had left home for a week without informing her parents.
