Department Activities Summary

1.–Project's Name: Get Ready Training Program

Staff in charge of report: Mr. Sok Sambor

I. Highlights

- GR Program graduated Get Ready for Boys cycle 4. Fourteen boys attended in this cycle. The course started on August 01st, 2012 and continued until January 25th, 2013 (6 months). All of the boys were either sent to attend state school, are working, or attending vocational training at NGO partners as following:
 - ❖ Two boys were sent to study at state school.
 - ❖ One boy is working as a Tuk Tuk driver.
 - ❖ Three boys were sent to study vocational training at Hagar Organization.
 - ❖ Eight boys were sent to study vocational training at Friend Organization.
- One boy, C.C., GRB III, who was sent to study motor repairing at Friend Organization, has graduated with his skill. He has two choices. First, Friend Organization could select him to be a Friend Organization's staff to be an assistant of a motor repairing teacher. Second, he could apply to work at a company.
- One boy, K.L., GRB II, who dropped out from air conditioning and returned to attend sewing class at Friend Organization, has graduated with his skill. Friend Organization's staff will work with him to run his own business at his home.
- One girl, C. C., GRG VIII, quit her skill study at Hagar Organization last month. However, she passed an exam to be an assistant to a teacher within Riverkids Foundation. She will start her work on February 05th, 2013 at Compassion House.
- One boy, N. U., GRB II, who dropped out from air conditioning and returned to attend sewing class at Friend Organization, has graduated with his skill. He is working in a factory using his skill. He earns \$5-7 per day.
- GR Program enrolled one girl who is a former student in an outside project to study in Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 at KM6. In total, there are 12 girls attending this class currently.

- GR Program cooperated with a DCA team leader to evaluate 3 families of Get Ready Girls who were enrolled in the program in December and January.
- GR Program started a pilot yoga class with Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 at KM6. This class will consist of ten sessions.
- GR Program sent 11 boys to attend a four day workshop about HIV/AIDS, domestic violence, and drug use, and how to set a plan. This was conducted by a nurse from Riverkids and foreign volunteers from Alexandra.
- GR Program conducted a single day workshop with Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 at KM6 about make up and cosmetics which was led by a Riverkids volunteer from Singapore.
- GR Program cooperated with the micro-business department to send 7 Get Ready for Boys cycle 4 and 12 Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 to attend a workshop about debt management at Aden Garden. The trainer for this workshop was Ms. Danielle, an Oxfam Quebec Marketing Advisor Volunteer.
- GR Program cooperated with the DCA unit to conduct a workshop about budgeting with 12 parents of Get Ready Girls cycle 9 and 5 families of the DCA pilot test at Blum House. This workshop was led by Mr. Sok Sambor, GR Program Coordinator, and Mr. Meth Savda, Micro-business Administrative Assistant.

II. Challenges

- This month, there were many workshops and unexpected activities so that the program did not conduct a field trip with Get Ready for Girls.
- GR Program needs transportation for students who have graduated from their program to attend vocational training at other NGO partners.

III. Plans for Next Month:

- GR Program is going to cooperate with social workers to recruit 10-15 boys from various communities to attend soft-training for Get Ready for Boys cycle 5 at Blum House.
- GR Program is going to complete the Get Ready for Boys cycle 4 final report for the Leadership team.

- GR Program is going to coordinate a field trip to Outdong Mountain for 12 girls from the Get Ready for Girls cycle 9.
- GR Program is going to cooperate with the micro-business department to coordinate a financial workshop for the girls in Get Ready for Girls cycle 9 to attend. This session will be conducted by Danielle, Oxfam Quebec Marketing Advisor Volunteer.
- Mr. Sambor is going to hold a three day meeting with Susan, a Riverkids volunteer, to create a structure map and system for use in the GR Program.
