School Supporting Program Monthly Report

Report for Month: February, 2013.

Main School Supporting Program Highlight:

- January monthly tuition fees have been paid for students who study at Toul Sangke, Ponheakrek student, and Little Bird student.
- We completed the transfer letter for Ponhea Krek Primary School. The letter and student study record have already been sent to Prek Pnoa Primary School.
- 11 students have finished doing entrance test at Westline School. 10 students are enrolled in Intensive English Program and one student has enrolled in Part-time English Program at Westline School.
- 7 students who enrolled in English as Second Language Program at Beltei International School have passed the final exam. We have paid for tuition fees of 7 students who are enrolled in ESL (English as Second Language).
- One student from Grade 2 has been reintegrated with family.
- We have met Toul Sovannaram School Director to discuss about our students who are enrolled in his school.
- One girl who graduated from Get Ready Girl has been reintegrated to Ponhea Krek Primary School in Grade 4.
- It has been agreed with Ponheakrek School Director that she accepts all our students that we want to integrate to her school. These students require only birth certificate, family book, or local authority letter clarifying children's date of birth to enroll in Ponheakrek Primary School. Entrance test and letter from Riverkids have been included.
- Meeting conducted with Empowering Youth School manager to monitor and follow up our student information.
- Two students who live at Compassion House are selected as team leaders for Toul Sangke and Kolap Primary School.
- A girl studying at Wat Phnom secondary school has received good grades in class.
- A 12 hours Advocacy Walk was led on February 05.

Main School Supporting Program Challenges

- 17 students who study at Ponheakrek Primary School are often absent from school without informing their teachers.
- Two students who study at Toul Sanke Primary are truant from class.



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School Scholarship (supporting) Program

- Three students who study at Toul Savannaram secondary School often truant from school and two students who study at Wat Phnom secondary and high school are not contactable.
- Two students who study at Ponheakrek Primary School were caught in a traffic accident while they were walking home.
- We are still facing difficulty in working with Wat Phnom Secondary and High school teachers and School Director. These people hesitate to allow us to visit their school and classrooms. They require us to give formal letter from Interior Minister and Ministry of Education Youth and Sport to the School Director for permission to do the same.
- Purchase of School bags for Beltei Students has been delayed. The school bags will be bought for students in March.
- Ponheak Primary School Director has requested that Riverkids donates money to build playground at her school.

Next month's plan for Schools Supporting:

- Pay for tuition fees of student who are enrolled in ESL program at Westline Private School.
- Pay for February monthly tuition fees students who study at Toul Sangke, Ponheakrek student, and Little Bird Student.
- Revise 6 students information at State and submit follow up student absentee form to social team.
- Monitor students who are attending at all State and Private schools.
- Provide transportation support and weekly tuition fee to Secondary and High school students
- Update student statistics with Casefile Coordinator.
- Meeting with Beltie Secondary and High school students to ensure that their study process and working process of team leaders is running smoothly. To buy 7 school bags for Beltei International School and pay for Semester II tuition fees at National University of Management's Student.
- Pay monthly food support to family at Little Bird Program
- Work with our social team for students who have problems at state school.
- Meet with Secondary and High school teachers and School Director.
- Monitor and encourage team leaders
