### Department Activities Summary

#### 1.–Project's Name: Get Ready Training Program

**Staff in charge of report: Mr. Sok Sambor**

#### **I. Highlights**

- GR Program cooperated with social workers to recruit nine boys from communities to attend soft-training to prepare them for Cycle Five at Blum House.
- GR Program completed the final report of GRB IV to send to the Leadership Team and Singapore office.
- GR Program coordinated 'Get Ready' training day for girls in Cycle Nine. This involved attending a workshop conducted by the Nurse Community and volunteers, on the topic of "HIV, Domestic Violence, Drug Use and Life skills" at Alexandra.
- GR Program, in cooperation with the Direct Cast Aid Team Leader held discussion groups with parents. Discussion topics included: "the progress of your child's education, how to protect you child from trafficking, and how to spend money effectively". Twelve mothers of GRG participants and five families from the DCA pilot programme attended this meeting.
- GR Program organized a field trip to the Outdong Mountain for GRG IX Cycle Nine
- GR Program met with Susan, a Riverkids Volunteer, to create a structured map and system for use in the Get Ready Training Program.
- Mr. Sok Sambor gave a training session to students about 'Saving.' This was conducted by the Micro-business unit at Aden Garden. There were fifteen women from Sewing Class, Handcraft, and Bootstrap in attendance at this workshop.
- Mr. Sok Sambor took three boys from Riverkids to attend vocational training courses entrance exams at Hagar Organization. Our boys passed all the tests and they all started their courses on the 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2013.
- Mr. Sok Sambor attended an evaluate workshop, conducted by the Chab Dai Coalition.

## **II. Challenges**

- Three boys that the program sent to study at Friends International are often absent. We need to work more closely with staff from Friends International to follow this up.
- GR program is having difficulty in recruiting for 'Get Ready for Boys' Cycle Five as recruiters are struggling with the current workload.
- One girl named SK, GRG IX, appears to be demotivated with her studies. She sleeps until 8:00am or 9:00am in the morning.

## **III. Plan for Next Month:**

- GR Program is going to cooperate with social workers to recruit two more boys and start the course of 'Get Ready - for boys' Cycle Five on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
- GR Program is going to cooperate with the DCA Team Lead to evaluate the families of the 'Get Ready - for boys' Cycle Five.
- GR program is going to conduct parent meetings with parents of the Get Ready students at Family House.
- MR is going to enroll in the GR Program to study mechanical skills at Friends Organization.
- GR Program is going to organize a field trip to Koh Oknha Tei for the 'Get Ready' students.
- GR Program is going to send eleven girls from 'Get Ready' to attend a workshop by Cha Pei Dong Weng at the Cambodian Living Art organization on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
- GR Program is going to continue Yoga class with 'Get Ready - for girls' Cycle Nine.
- Mr. Sok Sambor is going to meet with the president of Azahar Foundation, a supporter of these yoga classes.
- GR Program is going to advance, settle and provide pocket money and food boxes to students.
