I. MONTHLY REPORT SUMMARY:

A. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS:

- We helped to register 35 children at the Compassion House Center and worked with the social team to do family assessments of the applicants in Railway I and II communities. We also had the opportunity to open the classes and provide study materials for these 35 children, which were donated by Chab Dai, and started discussions with the orientation of RKF's program to the parents.
- We had a movie and exhibition outing to Bophana Center with 68 Grade School children and six kindergarten children.
- We received two TVs, two DVD players and two CD players from donors. One CD player is kept at Blum House, the two TVs and one DVD player are kept at Alexandra House, and the last CD player is now kept at Central Office Center.
- We took 65 children from Alexandra, Blum House, Compassion House, HM6 House to their dental health check at Happy Tree Orphanage.
- The roof of the Family House Center used for grade class and choir has been fixed and a wall fan was also installed at the side of the house.
- We recruited nine English and Computer students to join the English Classes at Westline School near the Family House Center. We now have 23 English Students, two Teacher Assistants and one Sewing Trainer Assistant in between the classes.

B. MAIN CHALLENGES:

- The cartoons and educational DVDs for our children at KM6 House, Compassion House, Alexandra/ Family House Center have yet to reach us.
- We are waiting for the arrival of the three assistant teachers to help our teachers at KM6 House, Family House, Compassion House, and Central Office Center.
- One kindergarten Teacher Krouch Chandara needs RKF to sponsor her to enroll in a Part Time English Class to build her English foundation. She is responsible for teaching the children at Compassion House Center.



- There are 3(F=1) children (unrelated cases) who refuse to open up for a whole month. Social Workers are trying their best to communicate with these children.
- The budget for transportation to football matches will have to increase due to Simple Football students having training on Saturday: \$16.5 (4 Tuk Tuk, including our own tuk tuk which would need petrol of \$1.5 per week & Senior Men Football Students to practice lesson on Sunday: \$ 5)

C. NEXT'S MONTH PLAN:

- We will be working together with the Team staff and teachers at Family House to **recruit 13 kindergarten children** from Psar Touch and Doeum Kvet communities.
- Continue cooperating with the childcare coordinator to complete the update of the kindergarten's English version curriculum.
- Arrange to send 60 Grade School and 35 Kindergarten students to Alexandra House Center to watch a movie at Bophana Center.
- Copy the Gogo Loves Level 4 work book for English students at Blum House Center.
- Buy State School books for the children.
