1.–Project's Name: Get Ready Training Program

Staff in charge of report: Mr. Sok Sambor

I. Highlights

- GR Program enrolled students to study computers at Riverkids. Eleven girls attended the morning session and eleven boys attended the afternoon session each Monday.
- GR Program cooperated with Hagar Organization to find two private shops for our boys studying vocational skills. C.S., GRB IV, was enrolled to study phone repairs at Kolap I at Toul Sangke village and C.B., GRB IV, was enrolled to study phone repairs at Phsar Chas market.
- GR Program cooperated with our Social Workers to recall former GR Girls S.S. and S.T., GRG VII, to be Kindergarten Class Assistants.
- GR Program cooperated with DCA Team Lead to hold a meeting with teachers, students, and parents. The topic of this meeting was “Good Relationships between Riverkids and Families, DCA Policy, Importance of Education, and Getting Feedback from Families”. 21 families, 22 students, two teachers, and the DCA Team Lead attended the meeting.
- Provided six bicycles to students who live some distance from their classrooms. These students are studying vocational training at NGO partners and in the private sector.
- GR Program coordinated with the Mekong Project to schedule counseling for our boys and girls.
- Mr. Sok Sambor will attend the First-Step forum, “More Than Gender”.

II. Challenges

- We were unable to go Kampong Chnang province to investigate a possible skill for our boys, as Hagar staff have delayed this schedule.
- Two boys who were studying vocational training at Friends International have ceased studying. L.B. is working as an electricity worker, earning \$80.00 per month. C.S. has joined a football team.

- One girl, T.T., GRG VIII, has ceased her skills training with Friends International as she is going to work as garment factory worker.

III. Plan for Next Month:

- GR Program GRG Cycle IX will graduate on on 25th, May, 2013. We will try to find skills and work for students after they have graduated.
- GR Program will compile a final report for the Get Ready Girls cycle IX for the Singapore office.
- GR Program to conduct individual parent meetings with all families of GRG to discuss their child's future after graduating the course.
- GR Program to coordinate with a volunteer (Andrea) to conduct a three day workshop with Get Ready Girls class. We will also work with the Mekong project to provide counseling to our boys and girls.
- GR Program to create a board of program activities for GR class.
- GR Program to coordinate GRB V to take a field trip to Chamka Pring resort.
