I. MONTHLY REPORT SUMMARY:

A. MAIN HIGHLIGHTS:

- Finished updating the Riverkids Kindergarten Curriculum Book in English Version.
- There were two students who returned this month. They are N P-M (male) and N S-F(female).
- Had the opportunity to coordinate 50 Grade School and Kindergarten kids at KM6 House Center to see both a movie and an exhibition at Bophana Center.
- Opened the kindergarten classes with 17 children, (12 females), and provided an orientation of the kindergarten program and conducted a family meeting at the Family House Center. We sent one grade class Teacher, Eng Sunheak, to teach and another teacher to coordinate .
- Had the opportunity to coordinate 20 Grade Classes at Compassion House with a Field Trip to Tamao Mountains, including two staff and six external volunteers.
- Had the opportunity to open internal football competition for 100 children, coordinated five external volunteers, two staff, an internal volunteer and four local coaches.
- Cooperated with Mr. Or Vitou and his team, IFL Lecture, RUPP on We Learn, We Teach, We Share Project to deliver a moral, sanitary, and child trafficking lesson to 40 grade class children at the Central Office Center.
- Madam, the Family House Center's owner with her relatives, visited our center and provided study material, soft drink and cake to 60 children at Riverkids Foundation. They donated USD200 to RKF.
- Two students were selected to represent Cambodia in the 2013 Homeless World Cup in Poznan, Poland from 10th to 18th August 2013. A third student was also selected as a reserve player. They are: LM-M and CB-M. N D-M is the reserve player.



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B. MAIN CHALLENGES:

- Compassion House needs repair as it floats when it rains. In addition, the house owner has informed us, they will stop renting the building to us in August 2013.
- Weekly Border Children at Family House Center needs more discipline from the childcare coordinator. The children often go to the computer class showing little respect for the Computer Teacher. In addition they sometimes create a mess in the kindergarten class by moving material around in the classes.
- There were 10 grade class and kindergarten class students who were absent for a whole month at different sites. They are CK-F, SS-F, PS-F, R K-F, T B-F, OS-F, SS-M, NY-M, CK-M and S P-M. The Social Work Team is struggling to communicate with the families and children.
- There were 27 computer students who were absent for a whole month.

C. NEXT MONTH'S PLAN:

- Perform Family Assessments (ABCD) for 10 Children in the Kindergarten Program.
- Coordinate work with both the Social Work Team and the School Support Program Team to determine the real challenges of the 27 computer students.
- Coordinate 100 English and Grade School Students for the internal football competition and training.
- Coordinate and send 72 Grade School students from the Central Office Center to experience a movie and exhibition at Bophana Center.
- Initiate school supplies order in weeks two and four and implement budget (cash Advance and settlements) every week.
- Coordinate teachers to complete lesson plans for day to day teaching at Family House, KM6, Compassion House, Blum House and Central Office.
- Help Mr. Sophon and social worker to choose and identify crisis families for Social Work objective of recruiting 56 crisis families.
