### OVERALL SUMMARY:

- ❖ There are 10 babies in the Baby Belly Program
  - 7 babies received celia cereal (14boxes p/mth)
  - 26 cans of formula milk provided to babies
  - 14 boxes of celia cereal provided to 7 babies
  - 2 babies graduated from the Baby Belly Program
  
- ❖ 75 patients received medical check ups and medicine from the nurse
  
- ❖ 4 clients were hospitalised
  
- ❖ 12 patients received check ups and medicine from the medical clinic doctor
  
- ❖ 4 babies in the baby room had follow up checks on their weight & height
  
- ❖ There are 4 pregnant women in HMHB
  - 2 women had a pre-natal check up
