## SW Consolidated Report April 2015

### Department Summary:

- 42 family visits in 46 sessions, which is according to RKF's target
- Followed-up on 13 cases of students who were absent from internal and external education programs
- Provided counseling to 14 families in 16 sessions
- Registered five clients for Kindergarten, one client for HMHB, one client for Sew Happy, one client for Hungry Children program

### Highlights:

- CFR Review of T.P. (CFR28.0405)
- Encouraged one GRB (V.K.) to study at Dignity House
- Provided 10kg of rice to T.S. (CFR37.0339)
- Mr. Phal Oudamsabath provided supervision to Ms. Bonareth, Mr. Songheang & Savda
- Prepared training document for TFF
- Completed 29 family assessments of potential families for Jasmine Elephant program
- Invited 20 families (who met Jasmine Elephant criteria) to meet with the program manager, who informed them about graduation
- SW supported the education and leadership teams in celebrating the Jasmine Elephant families
- Cooperated with purchaser to buy materials for Jasmine Elephant family
- Mr. Songheang and Mr. Chin Chea support school budget for the Little Bird Project
- Mr, Songheang and Mr. Chin Chea provided equipment for the Little Birds Project (six families at Kbal Koh) as follows:
  1. One mosquito net
  2. One blanket
  3. Two pair of shoes
  4. Two suits of secondhand clothes
- Mr. Him assisted the Childcare team in evaluating families whose children need to sign-in and out from the Weekly Boarding program: S.L. (F0645 ID0789), C.R. (F0269 ID0365)
- Paid home rental for P.S. (F0269)
- Assisted Childcare team with home visits
- M.S. (ID 0800), M.S. (ID 0801) have graduated
- Conducted home visit and met C.N.'s parents (F0401 H0008) with the childcare and program manager
- Mr. Him assisted nurse in HMHB client visits
- Connected with a community networker at Phsar Touch Sok Linda
- SW Team worked with volunteer Doris to provide her the opportunity to observe the SW activities in all target areas
- Provided \$10 for Y.K.S.'s mother's 7th day of federal ceremony
- Provided \$10 for C.S.'s mother's ceremony
- Cooperated with GR program to encourage four women to join Sew Happy
- Encouraged crisis families to meet with the doctor and nurse

### **Highlights:** (continued)

- Supported the nurse in visiting M.R. (HMHB F0685), who was injured by DV and sent to Calmet hospital by her mother-in-law. She is being supported by Friend NGO
- Three students dropped out from the RK Program:
  - ID:0856 was absent for four months due to belief and religion issues
  - ID:0872 asked to leave the program because he needs to work to support his aging grandmother and repay her debt from raising him and his sister
  - ID:0512 was absent from school for a period of five months
- Provided DCA support to:
  - Seven Get Ready Girls
  - 17 Crisis Families
  - Nine Get Ready Boys
- E.M. (ID 0916) graduated from the RK program and received support from aunt to study Khmer literature and English at the State and Private schools respectively

### **Challenges:**

- K.S. decided to study hairdressing with Friends International NGO two weeks ago (we had recruited him for GRB but were late in replying to him)
- N.J. (ID 0279) dropped out and would like to sell coffee at the Stung Mean Chey market
- T.C. (ID 0770) dropped out in order to find a better job in Svay Reang province
- P.T.T. (ID 0286) dropped out and joined other church
- At Compassion House, the social worker tried to recruit children for the Kindergarten program, but they did not meet Riverkids' criteria
- The Compassion House women have not yet expressed interest in the Get Ready program
- The staff members are concerned about the sudden requests for the Jasmine Family program, as it affects their wellbeing and other work plans with families in the communities. More advanced notice would be greatly appreciated in the future, in order to effectively plan resources accordingly and raise awareness in communities.
- Due to the sudden influx of tasks within a short period and limited manpower, the CFR meeting for the remaining eight families and DCA Program checklist have been delayed

- Conduct family visits
- Follow-up on cases of students who were absent from education programs
- Refer clients to counselor (following new process) and psychotherapist from Mekong (EMDR project)
- Provide basic counseling to clients
- Identify and register new clients in other RKF programs
- Participate in Social Team meeting twice a month
- Work with Mr. Phal Odom Sambath on technical support
- Cash advance and Cash settlement
- Write monthly report
- Provide DCA to Get Ready Program and Crisis Family
- Participate in "Supervision workshop"
- Support volunteer coordinator's survey program in the communities
- Prepare TFF training
