 - 8 boxes of celia cereal provided to 4 babies
 - 1 new baby registered in Baby Belly Program

- ❖ 35 patients received medical check ups and medicine from the nurse

- ❖ 3 clients were hospitalized

- ❖ 15 patients received check ups and medicine from medical clinic doctor

- ❖ 4 babies in the baby room had follow up checks on weight & height

- ❖ There are 5 pregnant women in HMHB
 - 1 woman had a pre natal check up
