1. Project's Name: Get Ready Training Programs

Staff in charge of report: Mr. Sok Sambor

I. Highlights

- The following two students have been engaged in work:
 - ❖ A male student S.B. works as a salesperson in BDC Co. Ltd . He receives a salary of 100 dollars and benefit of 20 dollars per month.
 - ❖ A female student T.P. bakes cakes. She receives 100 dollars per month.
- Get Ready Program graduates Get Ready girls cycle 12 have chosen the following paths:
 - ❖ There are four graduates attending skills workshop at Friends International
 - ❖ There are two graduates who will live and attend state school with NGO partners.
 - ❖ There is one graduate continuing her study at secondary school.
- Get Ready Program has completed 90 % of our Get Ready Women Policy and 40% of our Life Skills Book for implementation to the program in March 2015.
- Get Ready program co-operated with social workers to recruit six candidates, two of which are female, to attend Get Ready Girl cycle 13 and Boy cycle 8.
- GR Program conducted parent meetings individually with 24 students' parents. We discussed pathways that students had chosen and obtained feedback from parents regarding students' decisions and education of their children. We reviewed program policy and would like to build more co-operation between Riverkids and communities, thus providing monthly support to families.
- Get Ready program conducted teacher meetings discussing challenges and solutions to working with students effectively.

II. Challenges

- A student N.P. is absent from Friends International. Riverkids staff and Friends International are following up to try to convince her to return to school.
- The recruitment of girls from communities to attend Get Ready Girl cycle 13 is delayed.

III. Plan for Next Month:

- GR Program is going to find placement for five graduate girls and two boys for skilled work at NGO partners.
- GR Program is going to enrol two boys and five girls in Get Ready Boy cycle 8 and Girls cycle 13 respectively.
- GR Program is continuing to create a new policy and life skills book for Get Ready women.
- GR Program will submit a final report of Get Ready girls cycle 12 to the Singapore office.
- GR Program is going to co-operate with PSE to send one female student to live and study there.
- GR Program is going to conduct parent meetings with student families to discuss their child's study and their chosen pathways. GR Program will also provide DCA to families.
- GR Program is going to conduct teacher meetings to obtain feedback on how to work with youth effectively.
- GR Program is going to take students to an educational movie at Bophana Center.
- GR Program is going to loan three bikes to families of get ready students.
