• Children's Security Tag System

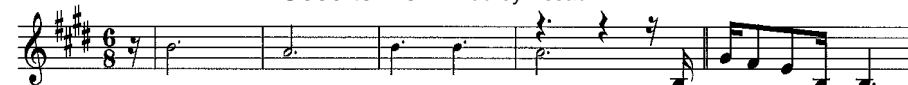

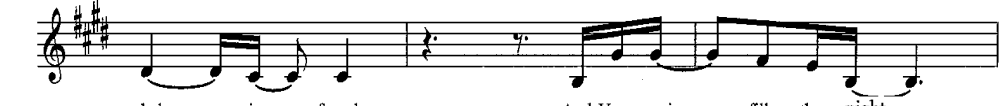

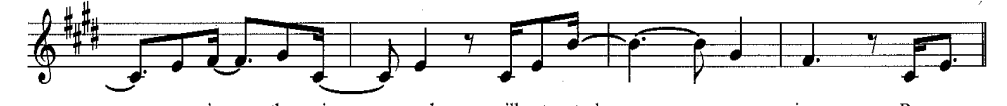
