### • Children's Security Tag System

• **The worship setting at Park Place is experienced by children** weekly in the Sanctuary. This is followed by their age level worship in Godly Play (ages 4-grade 5). The first Sunday of the month, children remain in worship with their families and church community to celebrate communion.
