## REFLECT ON THE GOSPEL

---

*“Do not let your hearts be troubled.”* JOHN 14:1

**T**here is no way anyone in the upper room was more troubled than Jesus. In just a few hours, he was going to be beaten, crowned with thorns, and crucified—and he knew it was going to happen. Still, he took the time to encourage his apostles. I may be leaving, he told them, but don't lose your faith or your peace over it. Trust me instead.

As the night went on, the apostles grew increasingly anxious and fearful—so much so that they ended up running away from Jesus. Their faith wasn't strong enough to sustain them when they faced a life-or-death situation.

But that's not how their story ends. Their faith returned when Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to them. They were so excited that they went out and set the world on fire for Jesus.

Were their hearts troubled after Jesus ascended into heaven? Yes, often. Did they lose their peace? Yes, often. Didn't they have the Holy Spirit in them? Yes. So why couldn't they hold firm? Because even the great apostles Peter, James, and John were still only human. Sometimes it takes time, even years, to develop that level of faith and trust.

So how do we regroup when our faith is tested? The best thing you can do is go easy on yourself. Remember how Peter lost his trust and denied even knowing the Lord. He wept bitterly when he realized what he had done, but he didn't remain trapped in that bitterness and guilt. When he saw Jesus on the Sea of Galilee, he jumped into the water and ran to him. He let Jesus reassure him, and he resolved to keep moving forward in faith.

So whenever your faith is tested, or whatever you are struggling with right now, remember that Jesus knows you. He knows your worries. He is with you, surrounding you with his love. Try your best to rest in him.

***Lord, help me to keep moving forward, to hold my peace, and to trust in you.***

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### St. Paschal Baylon

**Feast Day:** May 17

**Patron Saint** of shepherds and Eucharistic devotions, congresses and confraternities

Paschal Baylon was born to a poor shepherd family at Torre Hermosa in the Kingdom of Aragon (*No, not the guy from "Lord of the Rings"*). He worked as a shepherd for his father from the age of 7 to his mid-twenties. While tending to his flock, he would carry a book with him and beg those who he met to teach him the alphabet. In a short time, he learned how to read! At the age of 24, Paschal discerned religious life and joined the reformed Friars Minor of Peter of Alcántara. Though he was urged to study for the priesthood, he insisted on simply becoming lay brother instead. For 28 years, he lived a life in constant prayer and careful observation of the vow of poverty — he would never waste food or anything given to him and his fellow friars. He also devoted himself to the care of the sick and poor, and eventually developed a reputation of great generosity. He was so generous that the other friars sometimes had to moderate what he gave away.

Paschal Baylon is characterized by his intense devotion to the Mass and the Holy Eucharist. Toward the end of his life, he frequently spent time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

## YOUCAT CORNER

### Is it improper to call Mary the "Mother" of God?

No. Anyone who calls Mary the Mother of God thereby professes that her Son is God [495, 509]. As early Christianity was debating who Jesus was, the title *Theotokos* ("God-bearer") became the hallmark for the orthodox interpretation of Sacred Scripture: Mary did not give birth merely to a man who then after his birth "became" God; rather, even in her womb her child is the true Son of God. This debate is not about Mary in the first place; rather, it is again the question of whether Jesus is true man and true God at the same time.

### Why is Mary our mother also?

Mary is our mother because Jesus Christ gave her to us as a mother [963-966, 973]. "Woman, behold, your son! ... Behold, your Mother!" (John 19:26b-27a). The second command, which Jesus spoke from the Cross to John, has always been understood by the Church as an act of entrusting the whole Church to Mary. Thus, Mary is our mother, too. We may call upon her and ask her to intercede with God.
