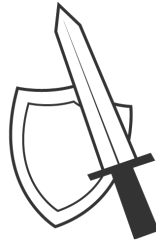

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### St. Joan of Arc

**Feast Day:** May 30

**Patron Saint** of soldiers and France



Whether we are young or old, we encounter times when it is difficult to follow what God is asking us to do because it means going out of our comfort zone and choosing to love others more than we love ourselves. It takes great courage and extraordinary faith to be obedient to the Lord's Will, especially when what He is asking of us seems close to impossible. But one thing is certain — when we trust and follow God, He will lead us to victory! St. Joan of Arc is a great example of what it means to be a soldier for God.

Born a peasant in what is now eastern France, Joan of Arc was a young girl during the Hundred Years' War between England and France. Early on, she claimed to have heard the voices of St. Michael, St. Catherine and St. Margaret giving her personal but general messages; but, at 13 years old, she started having visions of these 3 saints, each of them urging her and giving her instruction on how to save France. She responded to them saying she is weak and inadequate, but they assured her that this is God's command. This convinced her to finally give her "yes."

No one paid attention to Joan until some of her predictions of defeats in battle came true. It was then that people believed that her predictions came from Divine revelation. As her credentials were established, Joan was placed in a position of leadership and led the French to many victories. She led the French army wearing a full white armour and was accompanied by a banner with the symbol of the Holy Trinity and the words "Jesus, Maria." When she was eventually captured, the British had Joan burned at the stake for claiming to speak to God, wearing men's armour, and for using witchcraft and spells to win battles. With her gaze fixed on the Cross, she died calling on the name of Jesus.

## YOU CAT CORNER

### What does it mean to say that Jesus ascended into heaven?

With Jesus, one of us has arrived home with God and remains there forever. In his Son, God is close to us men in a human way. Moreover, Jesus says in the Gospel of John, "And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself" (John 12:32). [971]

In the New Testament, the Ascension of Christ marks the end of forty days during which the risen Lord was especially close to his disciples. At the end of this time, Christ, together with his whole humanity, enters into the glory of God. Sacred Scripture expresses this through the images of "cloud" and "heaven" or sky. "Man," says Pope Benedict XVI, "finds room in God." Jesus Christ is now with the Father, and from there he will come one day "to judge the living and the dead." Christ's Ascension into heaven means that Jesus is no longer visible on earth yet is still present.
