Privacy Policy – Effective Date March 20, 2015

General

This Privacy Policy describes the practices that Elevate International Management™

LLC, a Kentucky limited liability company (referred to hereinafter as “Elevate International Management™ “we”) follows with respect to the collection, use, maintenance and disclosure of information collected through elevate-international.com. This Privacy Policy applies only to information we collect from this Site, and does not apply to any other website or business activity of Elevate International Management.™ By using our Site, you consent to the collection, use, maintenance and disclosure of this information by us. We reserve the right to revise this policy at any time. When we do, we will give you notice of the revised Privacy Policy by posting the revised Privacy Policy on the Site and by revising the “effective date” at the top of this Privacy Policy. You are responsible for regularly reviewing the current privacy policy.

Information We Collect

We collect “personally identifiable information” and “usage information.” “Personally identifiable information” is information that tells us who you are, such as your name, physical address, and e-mail address. “Usage information” is information automatically collected by our web server (which may be hosted by a third-party) that your web browser makes available whenever you visit or use our Site, such as elevate-international.com. We may collect personally identifiable information when you create an account with our Site, edit or update your account information or if you voluntarily choose to provide it to us. For example, we may collect your first and last name, age, gender, physical address, e-mail address, phone number, and payment information. We do not store credit card information. You can choose not to provide personally identifiable information to us. However, if you do not provide such information, you will not be able to create an account so your ability to use the Site will be limited to those web pages available to unregistered users of the Site, and you will not be able to receive newsletters from us. Additionally, most browsers can be configured to reject cookies or alert you when cookies are being sent. However, if you refuse to accept cookies, it is possible that some portions of the Site may not function as intended. We may collect “usage information” anytime you view and/or interact with our Site or its pages, features and functionality. For example, we may collect your IP address, browser type, operating system version, and information regarding your browsing activities (e.g., information about the website that you visit before or after visiting the Site.) This Site may also use “cookies” and other technologies to recognize users, customize their experience or serve advertisements. A cookie is a small text file that a website’s server places on a user’s computer, mobile phone or other device. The cookie transmits information back to the website’s server about the browsing activities of the computer user on the site. This includes information such as pages and content viewed, the time and duration of visits and whether a computer user clicked on an advertisement. Cookies also can be used to recognize users and maintain data related to a particular individual, including passwords. In some contexts, such as where a number of separate websites participate in a network, cookies can be used to track a computer user across different sites. Cookies are used as a standard practice by many sites. As important as cookies are to our Site, if you would prefer not to accept cookies from our Site or any other website, you can modify the settings on your web browser. You may refer to your browser’s online help feature or user manual for instructions on how to do this. If you refuse to accept cookies, it is possible that some portions of the Site may not function as intended.

Disclosure and Use of Information We Collect

We use personally identifiable information for the purpose for which it is provided and for the other purposes described in this Privacy Policy. For example, we use personally identifiable information

to fill, confirm and ship your order and notify you of your order status; to communicate with you regarding your use of the site, prizes and other incentives, and for marketing and promotional purposes; to respond to e-mails; to provide customer support; to establish your online account; and to send newsletters to you. You may opt out from receiving marketing and promotional material at anytime. We may provide your personally identifiable information to third parties who provide services to us, including those who will deliver your order and/or provide billing services, and other third parties who provide services to us. We may disclose personally identifiable information to affiliated companies, our parent company and sister companies. We use usage information to customize the visitor's experience, study traffic patterns, and generally learn about the usage of the site. We may disclose this information to our shared affiliates. We use cookies to help us recognize when you visit our site and the website you visited immediately prior to our Site to help us recognize when you visited the website. We may use and disclose personally identifiable information and usage information when we have reason to believe that using and/or disclosing this information is necessary to investigate, identify, contact, or take action against someone who may have engaged in illegal activities or breached our Terms of Use or who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property, other users of our Site, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. We may also disclose personally identifiable information when we reasonably believe that the law requires it. We might sell or buy subsidiaries, or business units. In such transactions, personally identifiable information generally is one of the transferred business assets but remains subject to the promises made in any pre-existing Privacy Policy. Also, in the event that our assets are sold, personally identifiable information may be one of the transferred assets.

Privacy of Children

The Site is a general audience website. We do not intentionally collect personally identifiable information from users of this Site who are under the age of thirteen. If we become aware that a user of our Site is under the age of 13 and has placed an order using our Site, we will remove that child's personal information from our files.
