
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Mirrors and the Uncanny Opens July 15, 2023














Mirror #60, 2002 gelatin silver print mounted on aluminum 24×20 inches Edition 1 of 10




Martinique I, January 1972, 1972 gelatin silver print II x 14 inches (27.9 x 35.6 cm)


