- Title of position:** Green Team Crewmember
- Activities and Responsibilities:** Green Team Crewmembers get a summer experience like no other! This fun, hands-on, interactive opportunity is designed to engage middle and high school students in environmental stewardship. A wide variety of activities will help students to better understand conservation and agricultural lands, wildlife, and water resources.
- Green Team I Crewmembers will work primarily outdoors while acquiring new skills and knowledge. We will focus on trail maintenance, organic agriculture, and wildlife conservation. Crewmembers will be trained to safely use and handle hand tools to complete stewardship projects.
- Crewmembers will all meet at the Wildlands Trust headquarters and then be transported in company vehicles, traveling to different sites daily. Activities and responsibilities will be performed under the supervision of Wildlands Trust staff and under the guidance of local conservation professionals from various organizations in southeastern Massachusetts.
