- Title of position:** Green Team Crewmember
- Activities and Responsibilities:** Green Team Crewmembers get a summer experience like no other! This fun, hands-on, interactive opportunity is designed to engage high school students in environmental stewardship. A wide variety of activities will help students to better understand conservation and agricultural lands, wildlife, and water resources.
- Green Team II Crewmembers will work primarily outdoors while acquiring new skills and knowledge. We will focus on trail building and maintenance, carpentry, organic agriculture, wildlife conservation, water quality monitoring, and even camping skills. Crewmembers will be trained to safely use and handle hand tools and certain power tools to complete projects.
- Crewmembers will all meet at the Wildlands Trust headquarters and then be transported in company vehicles, traveling to different sites daily. Activities and responsibilities will be performed under the supervision of Wildlands Trust staff and under the guidance of local conservation professionals from various organizations in southeastern Massachusetts. Green Team II is complete with an overnight campout to practice essential camping skills, experience a night hike, and more!

- Must be between 15 and 18 years of age (ages 12 – 14 eligible for GT I).
 - Must be able to commit to the full session.
 - Ability to follow direction and work in a team setting.
 - Willingness to work outdoors daily in changing weather conditions.
 - Ability and willingness to perform physical labor including (but not limited to) kneeling, walking, hiking, and carrying tools.
