THE EDUCATION PHOTO PROJECT is a look at education and educators through photographs.

Photographer Sandra Steinbrecher creates a documentary portrait of three Chicago high schools facing profound challenges. While embedded in Harper, Fenger and Marshall High Schools, she recorded the struggles and triumphs of daily life in these schools. Her project includes images and stories of students and teachers, as well as journalists, activists, artists and politicians, capturing their energy and commitment. The exhibition provides a visual record of what it means to be a student and an educator in an urban school today.



SANDRA STEINBRECHER is a Chicago-based independent photographer who focuses mainly on documentary projects. She has exhibited her work at Grinnell College, Luther College, with the Chicago Photography Collective, the Chicago Public Library and the Battrell Gallery. Her photos appeared in the 2014 national docu-series, Chicagoland, on the Chicago Public Schools' and White House websites, on WTTW's Chicago Tonight program, in the Economist magazine and published in a hard cover photo book documenting life at Fenger High School.
