



# Jones Backcountry Adventure Grant + Jones Live Like Liz Award

Jones Snowboards and the American Alpine Club are proud to offer two new grants that encourage human-powered exploration of the winter wilderness by motivated amateur backcountry snowboarders. The **Jones Backcountry Adventure Grant** looks to support a multiday splitboarding expedition with a strong exploratory and adventure component. The project objective may focus on a single descent/summit or a tour/traverse of a region. Applicants with photo/video storytelling experience and social media experience will also be given special attention. The Jones Backcountry Adventure Grant offers \$1,500 plus a Jones splitboard, skins and backpack to the chosen applicant.

The **Jones Live Like Liz Award** has the same criteria as the Jones Backcountry Adventure Grant but the grant is open only to female applicants. In September 2014, Jones ambassador and aspiring mountain guide Liz Daley was killed in an avalanche accident in Argentina. This award is dedicated to Liz and the radiant passion for splitboard exploration that she was known for. The 2018 Jones Live Like Liz Award will also offer \$1500 plus a Jones splitboard, skins and backpack to the chosen applicant.

## **QUALIFYING CRITERIA:**

- AAC membership is required. AAC membership includes \$12,500 of combined rescue coverage, valid internationally through Global Rescue. Additional member benefits include gear discounts, access to AAC lodging facilities--including in the southern Talkeetna Mountains of Alaska as well as the Tetons in Wyoming, and much more. Short-term adult and discounted junior memberships for applicants under 29 are available. Learn more about member benefits to backcountry snowboarders and skiers and join today!
- The grant applicant **must be a U.S. citizen**. Expedition partners may be foreign citizens.
- Applicant must be at least 18 years of age and complete legal liability releases.
- Projects involving riders who are professionally sponsored or supported financially by corporate sponsors will not be considered. Proposals from "amateur" riders that receive

only in-kind corporate support will be considered, but support level should be disclosed.

Project location must be in North America. Project must be completed in 2018.

## **GRANT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS:**

The application period for the Jones Splitboard Adventure Grant and the Live Like Liz award is **December 1, 2017 to January 15, 2018**. No late applications will be accepted.

Award winners will be notified by January 31, 2018. Jones Snowboards company founder Jeremy Jones and Jones brand managers will review all applications and select the recipients.

- 4) Describe why you are motivated to seek out this expedition objective.

- 2) Describe the splitboarding experience of the team by listing significant backcountry descents or tours completed by each team member.
