- Counselors are the point people on the ground at Drop Zone. They are responsible for running the day to day activities, including setting up, tearing down and facilitating the daily program. However, the counselor's primary responsibility is to mentor students. The counselor is to strive to create a positive relationship with the students in order to become a positive role model in the student's lives.
- Required to complete a criminal record check, child abuse registry
- Attend training days
- The Counselors are responsible for:
 - Create deep relationships with youth
 - Be always available to talk with youth about their life
 - Work to create positive mentoring relationships with individual students
 - Setting up for the daily activities of Drop Zone
 - Cleaning up from the daily activities of Drop Zone
 - Checking in all attendees as they come
 - Checking out attendees as they leave
 - Working together with each other and the volunteers to create a safe and healthy and fun environment for all
 - Dealing with issues of health and safety which may arise
 - Provide support to the volunteers
 - Always be available to respond to the needs of attendees
 - Foster positive relationships with between attendees and volunteers
 - Handle minor issues which may arise
 - Large issues will be dealt with by the program director
 - Very Major issues will be the responsibility of the Lead Team
