

TEACHER AND SCHOOL SUPPORT

Classroom Accounts

In addition to funding School Office Supplies, the PTA also provides teachers with funds for classroom supplies.

Knowledge Center Support

Our school library and computer lab are housed in our Knowledge Center. PTA funding supports the extensive book and reference material collection, including an Internet-accessible catalog.

PE Teacher and Equipment

The PTA values the importance of Physical Education by providing funds to replace damaged PE equipment every year. The PTA also funds a Physical Education instructor for all students in grades TK-5. Half of the students in a classroom are taken outside for physical education twice per week, which compliments the Small Group Literacy Instruction (see Literacy section on reverse side.)

Outdoor Education Center

The OEC is an outdoor classroom / learning environment for the use of up to 50 students at a time. It is a place to learn about nature, water conservation, gardening, native plants, composting, and other environmental studies and much more.

Staff Appreciation Lunches

An opportunity for parent volunteers to show their appreciation for their teachers and office staff.

Teacher Professional Development and Planning Days

The PTA provides release days for teacher collaboration and professional development pertaining to the new Common Core State Standards and other pertinent content.

Library Clerk/Computer Lab Associate

The PTA funds a librarian/computer lab associate to support all students in grades TK-5 in the Knowledge Center.

STUDENT ENRICHMENT AND SUPPORT

Assemblies

A portion of the PTA funds support our Educational Assembly Programs. Scientists, historians, artists, musicians, storytellers and a variety of entertainers visit our school to enrich our academic program.

Field Day

Field Day is a great annual tradition at Marshall Lane with lots of outdoor activities for our TK-3rd grade students.

Yearbook

We are proud to be one of very few elementary schools to have a yearbook. The yearbook is designed and produced by parent volunteers.

Project Cornerstone

This is a countywide anti-bullying program sponsored by the YMCA and is aimed at supporting the healthy social development of all children and youth. Parent volunteers at Marshall Lane are actively involved in the ABC (Asset Building Champions) Reader program. Once per month, the ABC Parents read a book to their child's class and present an activity with the teacher's assistance.
