### **GENERAL WAIVER**

As a participant or as the parent/guardian of a participant in this program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury and I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, including death, damages, or loss which the participant or the participant's property may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with such program.

As a participant or as the parent/guardian of a participant in this program, I do hereby fully release, waive and discharge Shippensburg Community Park and Recreation Authority and its officers, agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims demands, or causes of action that may arise from injuries, including death, damage, or loss to person or property which I or the participant may have or which may accrue to me or the participant on account of my, or the participant's, participation in the program.

As a participant or as the parent/guardian of a participant in this program, I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend Shippensburg Community Park and Recreation Authority and its officers, agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims demands or causes of action that may arise from injuries, including death, damages, and losses to person or property sustained by the participant and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of the program.

### **REFUND POLICY**

I understand and agree to the activity refund policy that a full refund will only be given when a program or activity is cancelled by Shippensburg Community Park and Recreation Authority. A refund will not be issued if a program or activity is postponed. A refund request at least one week (1) prior to the program, will receive a refund less 10% or a \$3 surcharge fee, whichever is greater. NO REFUNDS will otherwise be given.

### **PHOTO RELEASE**

I give permission to Shippensburg Community Park and Recreation Authority for the free use of my likeness and that of my child or ward, in connection with any broadcast, telecast, video, photograph, print media, social media, or other publicity. By registering you consent to the Shippensburg Community Parks and Recreation Authority releasing your child's personally identifiable information in connection with its programs and activities. Personally, identifiable information includes participants name, photo or image, locations, and times of Shippensburg Community Parks and Recreation Authority program or activity.

### **Code of Conduct Contract**

- Play by the rules – the rules set forth in the Keystone Flag Football League and SCPRA.
- Act respectfully toward the officials and players of their own and opposing teams.
- Respect and follow the directions of the league, SCPRA and officials.
- Treat all players with respect, as you would want them to treat you.
- Act respectfully towards each other at all times. Abusive language is unacceptable.
- Avoid individual or collective behavior, which may reasonably be held by spectators to be offensive.
- Avoid all acts likely to incite spectators to violence or disorder.
- Make no detrimental statements in public (radio, television, print or electronic media) in respect to the performance of any officials, players, or any policy decisions of the league or SCPRA.
- Abide by the Rules & Regulations and the Competition Rules of the league and SCPRA.
- Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and SCPRA.
- Do not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability.
- Do not use information technology to make or post inappropriate comments against players, league officials, game officials, or SCPRA which is discriminatory or offensive. Information technology includes, but is not limited to, email, instant messaging, text messages, phone messages, digital images, website postings (including social media such as Facebook, Twitter and blogs).
- Use of drug and alcohol products, including chewing tobacco, cigarettes, and/or vaporizers are prohibited.
- Remember that you are there to enjoy the game. Enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, officials, spectators, league officials, and SCPRA staff. Physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognize all volunteers who give up their valuable time.
- Do not engage in physical and/or verbal intimidation, abuse or conduct toward any player, official, supporter, league official, or SCPRA staff. Such actions are totally unacceptable.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by spectators, coaches, officials or players.

The Code Conduct was created by SCPRA staff and approved by the SCPRA board of administration. This contract is to be up held at all times during the season. Failure to abide by this contract, league rules, and SCPRA rules can result in suspension and/or removal from the league. Team coaches will review the code of conducts with all players and each player will sign on the registration form.
