Hi Church,

At OurChurch we encourage everyone to be in a G3 group, it's a group of girls or three guys who commit to doing life deeper together. It's discipleship in community, a tool for personal growth which provides encouragement, commitment, accountability, and support for those involved.

There are two main areas of accountability as seen in Galatians 6:1-5.

- A steady and full diet of scripture (engaging in Daily Devotions).
- The confessing of sin and struggles through honest responses to accountability questions.

By upholding one another in accountability spiritual growth is cultivated. We encourage you to have the 'Paul & Timothy' principle active in your groups. Let me explain, the Dead Sea has no life because it only has water flowing into it and no output. It's the same way with discipleship. If we continually have lots

of input but have no way of giving out to others we become stagnate and dead. In your groups try to have a 'Paul' (someone who is spiritually further down the track than you) and a 'Timothy' (someone you can input into).

The power of the G3 concept is in the regular sharing of Devotions. Engaging in SOAP Devotions and Journaling. In this booklet you will find details about how to begin a SOAP Devotional routine with the Life Journal Reading Plan.

A HEALTHY G3 ...

- Meets weekly.
 - Includes people of the same gender.
 - Meets for one hour, starting and finishing on time.
 - Discusses devotions and accountability questions.
 - Each person takes a turn running the weekly session.
 - Where possible include a 'Paul' & 'Timothy' in your group.
 - Maintains confidentiality.
 - Accepts accountability.
 - Allows room for each individual to respond.
 - Supports one another in prayer.
 - Supports one another practically.
