



Tuition Schedule for ISD 2018-2019

Vision:

Notes: ¹We are expecting to start with a class of Pre-school through 1st grade. ²We'll have educational services for other grade levels. Tuition for middle school and high school will be higher than elementary education and will be published at a later date. Our online courses and blended learning will cover grades in which we don't have sufficient number of students to hire a teacher. This will most likely involve grades 6-12 initially. ³Organizations are encouraged to speak with the school director for enrolling children at ISD because of added capital development fees. ⁴This is base tuition for Online courses, rates increase for children in upper-elementary, middle-school, and high-school.

Policies:

The tuition policies of the International School of Djibouti are a part of the by-laws validated by the President and General Assembly of the Association of the International School of Djibouti and are as follows:

1. No tuition will be reimbursed after the beginning of each term.
2. Optional monthly payment plans are to be negotiated with the director of the school.
3. Failure to pay tuition may result in expulsion of the student in question.
4. Technology fee is assessed if student does not supply their own curriculum compatible laptop. Ask administration for compatibility requirements. This policy is only applicable for grades 3 and above.
5. Invoices that are unpaid by the due date will be assessed a late fee of 5%.
