The Civil War Round Table of Eastern Pennsylvania, Inc. is a non-profit organization dedicated to the education of its surrounding communities and to battlefield preservation. Membership is open to anyone with an interest in the Civil War. Our membership consists of students, scholars and "just people" interested in learning more about the Civil War. Membership dues are just \$25 per year. Full-time student membership is available for only \$10 annually.

Our organization meets once every month from September to June. We have a dinner meeting with guest speakers talking about various topics of interest to Civil War/American history enthusiasts. The meetings are usually the first Tuesday of the month and begin at 6:30 p.m. While reservations are required to attend the dinner, you may come to hear the speaker, who starts at 7:30 p.m., for a fee of \$5. The cost for the dinner and speaker is \$25.

The Civil War Round Table of Eastern PA also sponsors field trips. These field trips are conducted by historians who are experts in that area.
