materials

Baby-food jar, cleaned and label removed

Primer (DecoArt Primer-Sealer is a good one to try)

Acrylic craft paint in the color of your choice

Epoxy craft glue

Small plastic toys

Dish soap

1 tablespoon glitter or metallic confetti Paint the outside of the jar cap with primer and let it dry.

Paint the cap with acrylic paint, allow it to dry, and using epoxy, attach plastic toys to the inside of the cap. Fill the jar almost to the top with water and add a small squirt of dish soap. Add the glitter.

Screw the cap on tightly. Turn the jar upside down and shake. It's snowing!
