Meathead Hat

This hat provides just the foundation for a one-of-a-kind embellishment of your choice—be it an intarsia pirate patch, a giant safety pin, a plastic flower, or a crayon holster. The stitches are basic, but they are made with two strands of a slightly shiny yarn that adds just a hint of light and complexity.

SIZES Child (Adult Small/Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS 17 (18³/₄, 20¹/₂)" circumference. *Note: Hat stretches easily.*

YARN Brown Sheep Lamb's Pride Bulky (85% wool / 15% mohair; 125 yards / 4 ounces): 1 (2, 2) skeins. Shown in #M162 Mulberry (Child) and #M175 Bronze Patina (Large). Crayon holster designed by Heidi Butler (optional).

NEEDLES One pair of straight needles size US 15 (10 mm); one pair of straight needles size US 10 (6 mm) (optional, for Crayon Holster). Change needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

NOTIONS One optional embellishment, such as vintage button, big plastic flower, or 3 crayons

GAUGE 9 sts and 13 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch (St st) using larger needles and 2 strands of yarn held together

2x2 Rib

(multiple of 4 sts + 2; 1-row repeat)

Row 1 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you. Repeat Row 2 for 2x2 Rib.

HAT

With 2 strands of yarn held together and using larger needles, CO 38 (42, 46) sts. Begin 2x2 Rib. Work even for 6 rows, ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS): Change to St st; work even for 6 (8, 8) rows.

SHAPE HAT

SIZE LARGE ONLY

Setup Row (RS): K1, *k9, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-42 sts rem. Purl 1 row.

SIZES SMALL/MEDIUM AND LARGE

Next Row (RS): K1, *k8, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-38 sts rem. Purl 1 row.

ALL SIZES

Row 1: K1, *k7, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-34 sts rem.

Row 2 (and all WS Rows): Purl.

Row 3: K1, *k6, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-30 sts rem.

Row 5: K1, *k5, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-26 sts rem.

Row 7: K1, *k4, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-22 sts rem.

Row 9: K1, *k3, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-18 sts rem.

Row 11: K1, *k2, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-14 sts rem.

Row 13: K1, *k1, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-10 sts rem.

Row 15 and 17: K1, *k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1-4 sts rem after Row 17.

Row 19: *K2tog; rep from * to end-2 sts rem. Pass first st over last st and off the needle-1 st rem. Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Draw through rem st, pull tight and fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew back seam. Weave in ends. Sew on embellishment.

CRAYON HOLSTER (OPTIONAL)

Using 1 strand of yarn and smaller needles, CO 10 sts and work in St st for 10 rows, beginning with a knit row. Change to 1x1 Rib. Work even for 4 rows. BO all sts in pattern. Sew CO edge and side edges of Holster to Hat; fill with crayons.
