(Romans 3:23) Everyone has sinned. No one measures up to God's glory.

There is hope and good news! God sent Jesus to take the consequences for our sins. He did what we could never do, it is a gift from God because He loves us so much!

(John 3:16) God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life.

(2 Corinthians 5:21) Christ didn't have any sin. But God made him become sin for us. So we can be made right with God because of what Christ has done for us.

Jesus gave up His life for us so that we could have the gift of being with God forever. When someone gives you a gift, you have the accept the gift, right? I doubt many of us turn down gifts, but when someone gives you a gift and you open it and take it, you accepted it. In the same way, God wants us to accept this gift from Him. Heres what the Bible says:

(Ephesians 2:8-9) God's grace has saved you because of your faith in Christ. Your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's gift. ⁹It is not based on anything you have done. No one can brag about earning it.

(John 14:6) Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

SALVATION PRESENTATION:

(Romans 3:23) Everyone has sinned. No one measures up to God's glory.

(Romans 6:23) When you sin, the pay you get is death. But God gives you the gift of eternal life. That's because of what Christ Jesus our Lord has done.

You are not going to die when you sin, it doesn't really happen that way. The death the Bible is talking about is after your body dies on earth. If we stay sinners, it means that we are forever separated from God. The eternal life that God wants to give us is not here on earth, but in heaven with God!

There is hope and good news! God sent Jesus to take the consequences for our sins. He did what we could never do, it is a gift from God because He loves us so much!

(John 3:16) God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life.

In John 3:16 when it says "God gave His one and only Son" it means that God sent Jesus to live on earth. He lived a perfect and sinless life, He died (the consequence of sins) BUT then He rose from the dead! Crazy, right?! Jesus did so many miracles when He lived on earth, but this was the biggest one. Jesus gave up His life for us.

(Romans 5:8) But here is how God has shown his love for us. While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

(2 Corinthians 5:21) Christ didn't have any sin. But God made him become sin for us. So we can be made right with God because of what Christ has done for us.

(1 Peter 3:18) Christ also suffered once for sins. The one who did what is right suffered for those who don't do right. He suffered to bring you to God. His body was put to death. But the Holy Spirit brought him back to life.

Jesus gave up His life for us so that we could have the gift of being with God forever. When someone gives you a gift, you have the accept the gift, right? I doubt many of us turn down gifts, but when someone gives you a gift and you open it and take it, you accepted it. In the same way, God wants us to accept this gift from Him. So, if we want to, and feel like it is the right decision, how do we do that?

Here's what the Bible says:

(Ephesians 2:8-9) God's grace has saved you because of your faith in Christ. Your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's gift. It is not based on anything you have done. No one can brag about earning it.

You don't get this gift by being good enough, because we sin, we are not good enough to be with God forever. But that's why Jesus is "the way, the truth and the life" to get to be with God forever, it takes Jesus and when He did for us.

(John 14:6) Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

(Romans 10:9-10, 13) Say with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord." Believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead. Then you will be saved. ¹⁰With your heart you believe and are made right with God. With your mouth you say what you believe. And so you are saved... ¹³Scripture says, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."



- 1. We have to admit that we are sinners and need God's forgiveness. We have to talk to God. He knows our sins, but He wants us to talk to Him and tell Him what we did, and ask to be forgiven.
- 2. We have to believe that God sent Jesus to pay the price for our sins. That Jesus died, but 3 days later rose from the grave!
- 3. We have to commit to be in a relationship with God for the rest of our lives and try our best to live like God would want us to live; to live without sin.
- 4. We tell everyone about our decision to follow God and have Jesus Christ be the Lord of our life! One way we can do this through baptism.

We are going to fail, we will always sin, but being in a relationship with Jesus Christ means that He is the Lord of our lives. It means that He is always with us, and we will do our best to live in a way that shows other people the love of God and in a way that pleases God. Have kids respond on their prayer cards by writing a number 1, 2, 3, 4.
