

## Hello and Welcome Vermont Valley CSA Members!

My name is Peter Gentry, owner of One Barrel Brewing Company, and I am very excited to welcome you to our pick-up site. Here is some information to make the season go as smoothly as possible and to assure you get all of the delicious produce that is coming your way:

1. Please feel free to contact me at any time. My email is [peter.gentry@gmail.com](mailto:peter.gentry@gmail.com) (preferred) and my cell is 608-335-2294. For the first few weeks I will be there to help you with your share. We are also fortunate that One Barrel's trusty Thursday bartender, Sam, will be there any time that I am not. He will be able to help but please remember that he has his normal work to attend to so if he cannot easily answer your questions, just give me a call (10am – 8pm is best. And always leave a message).
2. Pick up time starts at 4pm on Thursdays. If you have not picked up your share by 9pm we will move it to our cooler for the night. Please do not attempt to pick up your share after 9pm. We will keep it nice and cool and fresh so simply contact me if you've forgotten and we can make arrangements for you to pick up your share on Friday.
3. If I do not hear from you by NOON on Friday, your share will be donated.
4. Please bring your own bags/boxes to transport you veggies home. We will have some bags available but don't forget that you cannot take the tubs your shares come in and we would far prefer you use your own reusable method of conveyance rather than our plastic bags.
5. When picking up your share you can park in the "Tex Tubb's" lot to our East. The church parking lot to our West is also a great option, as well as the Monona State Bank Lot (formerly the Chase Bank Lot) to the North. There is also plenty of street parking to be found.
6. Keep in mind that if you bike in to pick up your share on Thursday and show your helmet, your first beer (if you choose to have one) is only \$1! That solves any parking hassle AND gives your pocket book a little break.
7. PLEASE cross your name off the list after pick up. If your name isn't on the list, check with myself or Sam instead of just taking a box. We will get to the bottom of it and make sure you get your veggies and don't deprive anyone else of theirs.
8. We are also hosting a Farm Fresh Egg Share from StoneHaus Farm (their chickens eat our spent brewing grains!) so if interested in that, please see go to <http://stonehausfarm-verona.com/freerangechickens/> and sign up. There is nothing like fresh veg with a farm fresh fried egg on top!
