Arrival

- **Plan to arrive early for each session.** Because of the number of visitors on campus that day, parking and finding your way to the correct place may take some time. The first session (K-4th grade) is by far the more crowded, so please allow time to park and walk.

- **9:00 (5th grade – 8th grade)** – in Tucker Assembly Hall. Students not performing in the Middle School Chorus are welcome to sit with grandparents and enjoy refreshments.
- 9:20 Middle School students will be dismissed and will guide their grandparent(s) to their classrooms. Please remember to visit Computer Lab #1 to take a commemorative photo with your grandchild and to visit Mrs. Sewell's Usborne Book Booth in the Middle School hallway.
