HAMILTON, LOUDOUN COUNTY, VA., FRIDAY, MAY 4, 1878.

In 1878 Yardley T. Brown, at only twenty-two years of age, established the *Loudoun Telephone* in Hamilton, Virginia. For some time it was the only Republican newspaper in Northern Virginia. The *Loudoun Telephone* was in operation until 1902.
