### Dressage / Stadium / Cross Country

#### Rules

The rules and regulations for Eventing set out by Equine Canada for 2017 will be followed at the discretion of the officials. Section D of the Equine Canada rule book (available online) should be consulted for permitted bits, martingales and other equipment.

- Helmets must be worn while mounted or lunging.
- Current medical armbands must be worn in all phases.
- Protective vests are mandatory for the cross-country phase.
- Competitors are responsible for coming to tack check with the permitted equipment for each phase.
- Formal dress required in dressage phase, and strongly recommended in stadium phase.
- No sleeveless shirts permitted over fences. Collared shirts required for the stadium phase.
- **All Riders (Parent/Guardian if Junior) must sign an SRC waiver** (to be submitted with entry form).

#### Format

Saturday: Dressage 8:30 am start, followed by Stadium. Stadium will be run in an open gate format - riders will proceed directly to the stadium warm-up after dressage. Riders will be provided sufficient time to change tack. Stadium course will be open for walking Friday evening and before each division begins Dressage.

Sunday: Cross country (8:00am start with starter division). Course will be open for walking all day Saturday.

Cross country course open for schooling: Friday noon-6:00 p.m. **Riders must check in with office to receive a wristband prior to schooling. Entry packages can be picked up from the show office after 6:00pm on Friday.**

#### Entries

\$80 for each horse/rider combination. Same horse/rider combinations cannot cross-enter into other divisions. Refund after closing date: 50% of class and stabling fees **with vet certificate**, no refund without vet certificate. Before closing date: All fees will be refunded except \$20 administration fee. **Make cheques payable to Southlands Riding Club.**

#### Stabling

Stalls: \$40 per night (includes 2 bales of shavings). No day stalls. Additional shavings available for purchase at \$8.50/bale. Separate stall clean-out deposit cheque (\$30) required. Stabling is limited and will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis; tack stalls only available after all horse stabling requirements have been met. **Make cheques payable to Southlands Riding Club.**

#### Dressage

Equine Canada 2016 Dressage Tests. Starter: Entry Test 1, Pre-Entry and Entry: Entry Test 2, Pre-Training: Pre-Training Test 1. Readers permitted.

#### Stadium

Starter: 2'3", Pre-Entry: 2'6", Entry: 2'9", Pre-Training: 3'

#### Cross Country

Starter: 2'3" approx. 1200m@325mpm, Pre-Entry: 2'6" approx. 1500m@350mpm, Entry: 2'9" approx. 1800m@350mpm, Pre-Training: 3' approx. 2000m@400mpm

**Arrival on Friday:** 12 pm or later. RVs are welcome, but please note there are no RV hook-ups available at this event. Please follow parking signs.

Southlands Riding Club (the "OPERATOR") and its Directors, Trustees, agents, representatives, employees, volunteers, independent contractors, subcontractors, sponsors, successors and assigns (collectively the "RELEASEES")

**DEFINITIONS**

In this Agreement, the term "equestrian activities" shall include all activities, programs, events and services provided, sponsored, organized or hosted by the Operator including but not limited to: jumping, flat riding, lounging, hand walking, driving and any and all other forms of mounted and unmounted equestrian activities; use of equipment and facilities as provided by the Operator, including but not limited to jumping equipment, dressage fences and riding arenas .

**ASSUMPTION OF RISKS**

I am aware that my participation in equestrian activities involves many risks, dangers, and hazards, which could result in damage, loss or physical injury

to me, as well as damage or injury to animals owned by me. Some of these risks, dangers and hazards include, but are not limited to:

- Health: the risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist
- Premises: defective, dangerous or unsafe condition of the facilities, falls, collisions with objects, equipment or persons
- Use of Equipment: mechanical failure of the equipment; negligent design or manufacture of the equipment; the provision of or the failure by the Releasees to provide any warnings, directions, instructions or guidance as to the use of the equipment, failure to use or operate the equipment within my own ability
- Advice: negligent advice regarding equestrian activities
- My conduct and conduct of other persons; I acknowledge that such conduct, including my negligence and negligence of other persons, including NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES, may increase the risk of damage, loss, personal injury or death. I understand that the Releasees may fail to safeguard or protect me from the risk dangers and hazards of equestrian activities, some of which are referred to above.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the Releasees, allowing me to participate in equestrian activities, use its equipment and facilities and providing its equine services and consultation, I hereby agree as follows:

1. **TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** that I have or may in the future have against THE RELEASEES AND **TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES** from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I may suffer or that my next-of-kin may suffer as a result of my participation in equestrian activities DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, including but not limited to:

- Negligence on the part of the Releasees;
- Breach of contract by the Releasees;
- Breach of warranty on the part of the Releasees in respect of the design, manufacture, selection, installation, maintenance or adjustment of equipment;
- Breach of any statutory or other duty of care including any duty of care owed under the *Occupiers Liability Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996 c. 303, on the part of the Releasees; and
- Failure on the part of the Releasees to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers and hazards of equestrian activities, some of which are referred to in the Assumption of Risks section of this Agreement.

2. **TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES** from any and all liability for any damage, loss, expense or injury to any third party resulting from my participation in equestrian activities.

3. Despite the risks, dangers and hazards of equestrian activities, and fully understanding such risks, dangers and hazards, I wish to participate in equestrian activities with the Operator, and I **FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME** all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage and loss resulting there from.

4. This Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next-of-kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity.

**SAFETY:** I am familiar with the rules and regulations regarding the use of the facility. I am aware that there are staff available during office hours to answer any questions I may have as to the proper use of the facility.

In entering into this Agreement I am not relying on any oral, visual or written representations or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

**INSURANCE:** I am aware that the Releasees do not provide me with any disability, accident, liability or medical insurance or compensation, should I become injured or cause personal injury or property damage to any third party while participating in equestrian activities.

**JURISDICTION:** This Agreement and any rights, duties and obligation as between the parties to this Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia, and I agree to attorn solely to the jurisdiction of the Courts of The Province of British Columbia. Any litigation involving the parties to this Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of British Columbia
