## GOD THE SON

How did we come up with our belief in the Trinity?

We know the Son is God because Scripture attributes to him:

1. Divine \_\_\_\_\_ (Matt.9:6; Jn.1:3; Heb.1:3)
  2. Divine \_\_\_\_\_ (Jn.1:1; Mt.28:18-20; Jn.21:17)
  3. Divine \_\_\_\_\_ (Jn.20:28; Rom.9:5; 1Jn.5:20)
- Divine \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb.1:6; Jn.5:23)

The Son is human because Scripture attributes to him:

1. Human \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt.4:2; Jn.11:35, 19:28; Hb.4:14-16)
  2. Human \_\_\_\_\_ (Lk.24:39; Mt.26:38)
- Human \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Tim. 2:5)
