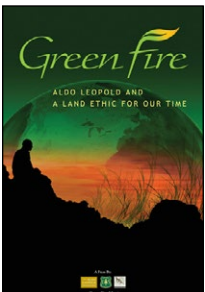
THE ZOOKEEPER'S WIFE (PG-13)

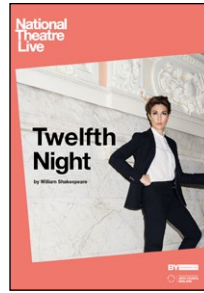
